

Joh 10:9 I am the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture.

Joh 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: **I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.**

Joh 10:11 I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep.

abundant=perissos

per-is-sos'

From G4012 (in the sense of **beyond**); **superabundant (in quantity) or superior (in quality)**; by implication **excessive**; adverb (with G1537) *violently*; neuter (as noun) *preeminence*: - exceeding abundantly above, more abundantly, advantage, exceedingly, **very highly, beyond measure**, more, superfluous, vehement [-ly].

perissos

Thayer Definition:

- 1) exceeding some number or measure or rank or need
 - 1a) **over and above, more than is necessary, superadded**
 - 1a1) **exceeding abundantly, supremely**
 - 1a2) **something further, more, much more than all, more plainly**
 - 1b) **superior, extraordinary, surpassing,**

Eph_3:20 Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us,

Psa 36:7 How excellent *is* thy lovingkindness, O God! therefore the children of men put their trust under the shadow of thy wings.

Psa_36:8 They shall be abundantly satisfied with the fatness of thy house; and thou shalt make them drink of the river of thy pleasures.

Psa 36:9 For with thee *is* the fountain of life: in thy light shall we see light.

Psa_16:11 Thou wilt shew me the path of life: **in thy presence *is* fullness of joy**; at thy right hand *there are* pleasures for evermore.

Psa_17:15 As for me, **I will behold thy face in righteousness: I shall be satisfied**, when I awake, with thy likeness.

Psa_63:3 Because thy lovingkindness *is better than life*, my lips shall praise thee.

Psa 63:4 Thus will I bless thee while I live: I will lift up my hands in thy name.

Psa_63:5 **My soul shall be satisfied as with marrow and fatness; and my mouth shall praise thee with joyful lips:**

Psa 63:6 When I remember thee upon my bed, *and*
meditate on thee in the *night* watches.

Psa 63:7 Because thou hast been my help, therefore in
the shadow of thy wings will I rejoice.

Psa 63:8 My soul followeth hard after thee: thy right
hand upholdeth me.

Act 2:28 Thou hast made known to me the ways of life;
**thou shalt make me full of joy with thy
countenance.**

Act 2:28 You have made known to me the ways of life;
You will enrapture me [*diffusing my soul with joy*] with
and in Your presence. [Ps. 16:8-11.]

Psa 4:7 Thou hast put gladness in my heart, more than
in the time *that* their corn and their wine increased.

Psa 4:8 I will both lay me down in peace, and sleep: for
thou, LORD, only makest me dwell in safety.

Psa 37:3 Trust in the LORD, and do good; so shalt thou
dwell in the land, and verily **thou shalt be fed**.

Psa 37:4 Delight thyself also in the LORD; and **he
shall give thee the desires of thine heart.**

Psa 37:5 Commit thy way unto the LORD; trust also in
him; and **he shall bring it to pass**.

Psa 37:6 And he shall bring forth thy righteousness as
the light, and thy judgment as the noonday.

Psa 37:7 Rest in the LORD, and wait patiently for him:
fret not thyself because of him who prospereth in his
way, because of the man who bringeth wicked
devices to pass.

Psa 37:8 Cease from anger, and forsake wrath: fret not
thyself in any wise to do evil.

Psa 37:9 For evildoers shall be cut off: but those that
wait upon the LORD, they shall inherit the earth.

Psa 37:10 For yet a little while, and the wicked *shall* not
be: yea, thou shalt diligently consider his place, and it
shall not *be*.

**Psa 37:11 But the meek shall inherit the earth; and
shall delight themselves in the abundance of
peace.**

Psa 72:6 He shall come down like rain upon the mown
grass: as showers *that* water the earth.

**Psa 72:7 In his days shall the righteous flourish;
and abundance of peace so long as the moon
endureth.**

Isa 58:14 Then shalt thou delight thyself in the LORD;
and I will cause thee to ride upon the high places
of the earth, and feed thee with the heritage of Jacob
thy father: for the mouth of the LORD hath spoken *it*.

**Isa 26:3 Thou wilt keep *him* in perfect peace, whose
mind *is* stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee.**

Rom 6:4 Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so **we also should walk in newness of life.**

Psa 25:12 What man *is* he that feareth the LORD? him shall he teach in the way *that* he shall choose.

Psa 25:13 **His soul shall dwell at ease;** and his seed shall inherit the earth.

Psa 25:14 The secret of the LORD *is* with them that fear him; and he will shew them his covenant.

Psa 25:15 Mine eyes are ever toward the LORD; for **he shall pluck my feet out of the net.**

Eph 3:19 And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that **ye might be filled with all the fulness of God.**

Psa 65:4 Blessed *is the man whom* thou choosest, and causest to approach *unto thee, that* he may dwell in thy courts: **we shall be satisfied with the goodness of thy house,** even of thy holy temple.

Isa 25:6 And in this mountain shall the LORD of hosts make unto all people a feast of fat things, a feast of wines on the lees, of fat things full of marrow, of wines on the lees well refined.

Isa 55:1 Ho, every one that thirsteth, come ye to the waters, and he that hath no money; come ye, buy, and eat; yea, come, buy wine and milk without money and without price.

Isa 55:2 Wherefore do ye spend money for *that which is* not bread? and your labour for *that which* satisfieth not? **hearken diligently unto me, and eat ye *that which is* good, and let your soul delight itself in fatness.**

Isa 55:3 Incline your ear, and come unto me: hear, and your soul shall live; and I will make an everlasting covenant with you, even the sure mercies of David.

1Co 2:9 But as it is written, **Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him.**

1Co 2:10 But God hath revealed *them* unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God.

1Co 2:11 For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God.

1Co 2:12 Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that **we might know the things that are freely given to us of God.**

Eph 1:18 The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the **riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints,**

Eph 1:19 And what *is* the **exceeding greatness of his power to us-ward who believe**, according to the working of his mighty power,

Eph 1:20 Which he wrought in Christ, when he raised him from the dead, and set *him* at his own right hand in the heavenly *places*,

Rom 5:15 But not as the offence, so also *is* the free gift. For if through the offence of one many be dead, **much more** the grace of God, and the gift by grace, *which is* by one man, Jesus Christ, hath abounded unto many.

Rom 5:17 For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; **much more** they which **receive abundance of grace** and of the gift of righteousness **shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ.)**

Jer 32:17 Ah Lord GOD! behold, thou hast made the heaven and the earth by thy great power and stretched out arm, ***and there is nothing too hard for thee:***

Mat 5:6 Blessed ***are*** they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for ***they shall be filled.***

Heb 13:20 Now the God of peace, that brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant,

Heb 13:21 **Make you perfect in every good work to do his will, working in you** that which is wellpleasing in his sight, **through Jesus Christ;** to whom *be* glory for ever and ever. Amen.

Joh 7:37 In the last day, that great *day* of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink.

Joh 7:38 He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water.

Joh 7:39 (But this spake he of the Spirit, which they that believe on him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet *given*; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.)

Psa 21:4 **He asked life of thee, and thou gavest it him, even length of days** for ever and ever.

Psa 21:5 His glory *is* great in thy salvation: honour and majesty hast thou laid upon him.

Psa 21:6 For **thou hast made him most blessed for ever: thou hast made him exceeding glad with thy countenance.**

Psa 145:18 The LORD *is* nigh unto all them that call upon him, to all that call upon him in truth.

Psa 145:19 **He will fulfil the desire of them that fear him:** he also will hear their cry, and will save them.

Psa 145:20 The LORD preserveth all them that love him: but all the wicked will he destroy.

Joh 15:7 If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, **ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you.**

Joh 15:8 Herein is my Father glorified, that ye **bear much fruit;** so shall ye be my disciples.

1Jn 5:14 And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, **if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us:**

1Jn 5:15 And if we know that he hear us, **whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him.**
