

Benefits Of Trust!!

Psa 32:10 Many sorrows shall be to the wicked: but **he that trusteth in the LORD, mercy shall compass him about.**

Psa 2:12 Kiss the Son, lest he be angry, and ye perish from the way, when his wrath is kindled but a little. **Blessed are all they that put their trust in him.**

Psa 5:11 But **let all those that put their trust in thee rejoice:** let them ever shout for joy, because **thou defendest them:** let them also that love thy name be joyful in thee.

Psa_5:12 For thou, LORD, wilt bless the righteous; **with favour wilt thou compass him as with a shield.**

Psa 34:8 O taste and see that the LORD is good: **blessed is the man that trusteth in him.**

Psa 34:9 O fear the LORD, ye his saints: for there is **no want to them** that fear him.

Psa 34:10 The young lions do lack, and suffer hunger: but **they that seek the LORD shall not want any good thing.**

Psa 40:2 He brought me up also out of an horrible pit, out of the miry clay, and set my feet upon a rock, and established my goings.

Psa 40:3 And he hath put a new song in my mouth, even praise unto our God: many shall see it, and fear, and shall trust in the LORD.

Psa 40:4 **Blessed is that man that maketh the LORD his trust,** and respecteth not the proud, nor such as turn aside to lies.

Psa 84:12 O LORD of hosts, **blessed is the man that trusteth in thee.**

Psa 146:3 Put not your trust in princes, nor in the son of man, in whom there is no help.

Psa 146:4 His breath goeth forth, he returneth to his earth; in that very day his thoughts perish.

Psa 146:5 Happy is he that hath the God of Jacob for his help, whose hope is in the LORD his God:

Psa 146:6 Which made heaven, and earth, the sea, and all that therein is: which keepeth truth for ever:

Psa 147:10 He delighteth not in the strength of the horse: he taketh not pleasure in the legs of a man.

Psa 147:11 The LORD taketh pleasure in them that fear him, in those that hope in his mercy.

Psa 147:12 Praise the LORD, O Jerusalem; praise thy God, O Zion.

Psa 147:13 For he hath strengthened the bars of thy gates; **he hath blessed thy children within thee.**

Psa 147:14 **He maketh peace in thy borders,** and filleth thee with the finest of the wheat.

Psa 147:15 **He sendeth forth his commandment upon earth: his word runneth very swiftly.**

Pro 16:20 He that handleth a matter wisely shall find good: and **whoso trusteth in the LORD, happy is he.**

Isa 12:2 Behold, God is my salvation; **I will trust, and not be afraid: for the LORD JEHOVAH is my strength and my song; he also is become my salvation.**

Isa 12:3 Therefore **with joy shall ye draw water out of the wells of salvation.**

Jer 17:5 Thus saith the LORD; **Cursed be the man that trusteth in man**, and maketh flesh his arm, and whose heart departeth from the LORD.

Jer 17:6 For he shall be like the heath in the desert, and shall not see when good cometh; but shall inhabit the parched places in the wilderness, in a salt land and not inhabited.

Jer 17:7 **Blessed is the man that trusteth in the LORD, and whose hope the LORD is.**

Jer 17:8 For **he shall be as a tree planted by the waters**, and that spreadeth out her roots by the river, and shall not see when heat cometh, but her leaf shall be green; and shall not be careful in the year of drought, neither shall cease from yielding fruit.

Rom 9:33 As it is written, Behold, I lay in Sion a stumblingstone and rock of offence: and **whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed.**

Rom 10:6 But the righteousness which is of faith speaketh on this wise, Say not in thine heart, Who shall ascend into heaven? (that is, to bring Christ down from above:)

Rom 10:7 Or, Who shall descend into the deep? (that is, to bring up Christ again from the dead.)

Rom 10:8 But what saith it? **The word is nigh thee, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, the word of faith, which we preach;**

Rom 10:9 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, **thou shalt be saved.**

Rom 10:10 For with **the heart man believeth unto righteousness;** and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

Rom 10:11 For the scripture saith, **Whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed.**

Eph 1:12 That we should be to the praise of his glory, who first trusted in Christ.

Eph 1:13 In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: **in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise,**

Eph 1:14 **Which is the earnest of our inheritance** until the redemption of the purchased possession, unto the praise of his glory.

1Pe 1:18 Forasmuch as ye **know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things**, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers;

1Pe 1:19 **But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot:**

1Pe 1:20 Who verily was foreordained before the foundation of the world, but was manifest in these last times for you,

1Pe 1:21 **Who by him do believe in God**, that raised him up from the dead, and gave him glory; that your faith and hope might be in God.

Rom 1:16 For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for **it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth**; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.

Rom 1:17 For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, The just shall live by faith.

Mar 16:15 And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature.

Mar 16:16 **He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved**; but he that believeth not shall be damned.

Mar 16:17 And **these signs shall follow them that believe**; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;

Mar 16:18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

Mar 16:19 So then after the Lord had spoken unto them, he was received up into heaven, and sat on the right hand of God.

Mar 16:20 And they went forth, and preached every where, **the Lord working with them, and confirming the word with signs following.** Amen.

Act 10:43 To him give all the prophets witness, that through his name **whosoever believeth in him shall receive remission of sins.**

Act 13:38 Be it known unto you therefore, men and brethren, that through this man is preached unto you the forgiveness of sins:

Act 13:39 And **by him all that believe are justified from all things,** from which ye could not be justified by the law of Moses.

Act 16:31 And they said, **Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house.**

Gal 3:2 This only would I learn of you, Received ye the Spirit by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith?

Gal 3:3 Are ye so foolish? having begun in the Spirit, are ye now made perfect by the flesh?

Gal 3:4 Have ye suffered so many things in vain? if it be yet in vain.

Gal 3:5 He therefore that ministereth to you the Spirit, and **worketh miracles among you, doeth he it by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith?**

Gal 3:6 Even as **Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness.**

Gal 3:7 Know ye therefore that **they which are of faith, the same are the children of Abraham.**

Gal 3:8 And the scripture, foreseeing that **God would justify the heathen through faith**, preached before the gospel unto Abraham, saying, **In thee shall all nations be blessed.**

Gal 3:9 So then **they which be of faith are blessed with faithful Abraham.**

Gal 3:10 For as many as are of the works of the law are under the curse: for it is written, Cursed is every one that continueth not in all things which are written in the book of the law to do them.

Gal 3:11 But that no man is justified by the law in the sight of God, it is evident: for, **The just shall live by faith.**

Gal 3:12 And the law is not of faith: but, The man that doeth them shall live in them.

Gal 3:13 **Christ hath redeemed us from the curse** of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree:

Gal 3:14 That **the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ**; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit **through faith.**

Gal 3:15 Brethren, I speak after the manner of men; Though it be but a man's covenant, yet if it be confirmed, no man disannulleth, or addeth thereto.

Gal 3:16 Now to Abraham and his seed were the promises made. He saith not, And to seeds, as of many; but as of one, And to thy seed, which is Christ.

Gal 3:26 For **ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus.**

Gal 3:29 And if ye be **Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.**

1Ti 4:10 For therefore we both labour and suffer reproach, because **we trust in the living God, who is the Saviour of all men,** specially of those that believe.

1Ti 6:17 Charge them that are rich in this world, that they be not highminded, **nor trust in uncertain riches, but in the living God, who giveth us richly all things to enjoy;**

1Ti 6:18 That they do good, that they be rich in good works, ready to distribute, willing to communicate;

1Ti 6:19 Laying up in store for themselves a good foundation against the time to come, that they may lay hold on eternal life.

Psa 37:39 But the salvation of the righteous is of the LORD: he is their strength in the time of trouble.

Psa 37:40 And the LORD shall help them, and deliver them: he shall deliver them from the wicked, and save them, **because they trust in him.**

Psa 52:8 But I am like a green olive tree in the house of God: **I trust in the mercy of God for ever and ever.**

Psa 52:9 I will praise thee for ever, because thou hast done it: and I will wait on thy name; for it is good before thy saints.

Psa 84:12 O LORD of hosts, **blessed is the man that trusteth in thee.**

Psa 84:11 For the LORD God is a sun and shield: the LORD will give grace and glory: **no good thing will he withhold** from them that walk uprightly.

Psa 84:10 For a day in thy courts is better than a thousand. I had rather be a doorkeeper in the house of my God, than to dwell in the tents of wickedness.

Psa 112:7 He shall not be afraid of evil tidings: **his heart is fixed, trusting in the LORD.**

Psa 112:8 His heart is established, he shall not be afraid, until he see his desire upon his enemies.

Psa 118:7 The LORD taketh my part with them that help me: therefore shall I see my desire upon them that hate me.

Psa 118:8 **It is better to trust in the LORD than to put confidence in man.**

Psa 118:9 It is better to trust in the LORD than to put confidence in princes.

Isa 12:2 Behold, God is my salvation; **I will trust, and not be afraid:** for the LORD JEHOVAH is my strength and my song; he also is become my salvation.

Isa 12:3 Therefore with joy shall ye draw water out of the wells of salvation.
