Psa 73:26 My flesh and my heart faileth: **but God** is the strength of my heart, and my portion for ever.

Gen 20:2 And Abraham said of Sarah his wife, She is my sister: and Abimelech king of Gerar sent, and took Sarah.

Gen 20:3 **But God** came to Abimelech in a dream by night, and said to him, Behold, thou art but a dead man, for the woman which thou hast taken; for she is a man's wife.

Gen 45:8 So now it was not you that sent me hither, **but God**: and he hath made me a father to Pharaoh, and lord of all his house, and a ruler throughout all the land of Egypt.

Gen 31:7 And your father hath deceived me, and changed my wages ten times; **but God** suffered him not to hurt me.

Gen 50:20 But as for you, ye thought evil against me; **but God** meant it unto good, to bring to pass, as it is this day, to save much people alive.

Exo 13:17 And it came to pass, when Pharaoh had let the people go, that God led them not through the way of the land of the Philistines, although that was near; for God said, Lest peradventure the people repent when they see war, and they return to Egypt:

1Sa 23:14 And David abode in the wilderness in strong holds, and remained in a mountain in the wilderness of Ziph. And Saul sought him every day, **but God** delivered him not into his hand.

2Ch 20:15 And he said, Hearken ye, all Judah, and ye inhabitants of Jerusalem, and thou king Jehoshaphat, Thus saith the LORD unto you, Be not afraid nor dismayed by reason of this great multitude; for the battle is not yours, **but God's**.

Psa 49:14 Like sheep they are laid in the grave; death shall feed on them; and the upright shall have dominion over them in the morning; and their beauty shall consume in the grave from their dwelling.

Psa 49:15 **But God** will redeem my soul from the power of the grave: for he shall receive me. Selah.

Psa 64:6 They search out iniquities; they accomplish a diligent search: both the inward thought of every one of them, and the heart, is deep.

Psa 64:7 **But God** shall shoot at them with an arrow; suddenly shall they be wounded.

Psa 68:21 **But God** shall wound the head of his enemies, and the hairy scalp of such an one as goeth on still in his trespasses.

Psa 75:7 **But God** is the judge: he putteth down one, and setteth up another.

Isa 17:13 The nations shall rush like the rushing of many waters: **but God** shall rebuke them, and they shall flee far off, and shall be chased as the chaff of the mountains before the wind, and like a rolling thing before the whirlwind.
