1Pe 5:6 Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, that he may exalt you in due time:

1Pe 5:7 Casting all your care upon him; for he careth for you.

Mat 13:22 He also that received seed among the thorns is he that heareth the word; and **the care of this world, and the deceitfulness of riches, choke the word**, and he becometh unfruitful.

Mat 13:23 But he that received seed into the good ground is he that heareth the word, and understandeth it; which also beareth fruit, and bringeth forth, some an hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty.

Luk 21:34 And **take heed to yourselves**, lest at any time your hearts be overcharged with surfeiting, and drunkenness, and **cares of this life**, and so that day come upon you unawares.

Luk 21:35 For as a snare shall it come on all them that dwell on the face of the whole earth.

Luk 10:41 And Jesus answered and said unto her, Martha, Martha, **thou art careful and troubled about many things:**

Luk 10:42 But one thing is needful: and Mary hath chosen that good part, which shall not be taken away from her.

Php 4:6 **Be careful(anxious) for nothing;** but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.

Php 4:7 And **the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.**

Php 4:8 Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, **think on these things.**

Psa 27:13 **I had fainted, unless I had believed to see the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living.**

Psa 55:22 **Cast thy burden upon the LORD,** and he shall sustain thee: he shall never suffer the righteous to be moved.

Psa 56:3 **What time I am afraid, I will trust in thee.**

Psa 56:4 In God I will praise his word, in God I have put my trust; I will not fear what flesh can do unto me.

Heb 13:5 Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, **I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.**

Heb 13:6 So that we may boldly say, **The Lord is my helper, and I will not fear what man shall do unto me.**

Psa 142:3 When my spirit was overwhelmed within me, then thou knewest my path. In the way wherein I walked have they privily laid a snare for me.

Psa 142:4 I looked on my right hand, and beheld, but there was no man that would know me: refuge failed me; no man cared for my soul.

Psa 142:5 **I cried unto thee, O LORD: I said, Thou art my refuge and my portion in the land of the living.**

Mat 6:26 Behold the fowls of the air: for they sow not, neither do they reap, nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feedeth them. **Are ye not much better than they?**

Luk 12:31 But rather **seek ye the kingdom of God; and all these things shall be added unto you.**

Luk 12:32 **Fear not**, little flock; for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom.

Psa 37:3 **Trust** in the LORD, and do good; so shalt thou dwell in the land, and verily thou shalt be fed.

Psa 37:4 **Delight** thyself also in the LORD; and he shall give thee the desires of thine heart.

Psa 37:5 **Commit thy way** unto the LORD; trust also in him; and he shall bring it to pass.

Psa 37:7 **Rest in the LORD**, and wait patiently for him: fret not thyself because of him who prospereth in his way, because of the man who bringeth wicked devices to pass.

Psa 42:10 As with a sword in my bones, mine enemies reproach me; while they say daily unto me, Where is thy God?

Psa 42:11 **Why art thou cast down, O my soul? and why art thou disquieted within me? hope thou in God:** for I shall yet praise him, who is the health of my countenance, and my God.

Psa 62:5 My soul, wait thou only upon God; for **my expectation is from him.**

Psa 62:6 He only is my rock and my salvation: he is my defence; **I shall not be moved.**

Psa 62:7 In God is my salvation and my glory: the rock of my strength, and my refuge, is in God.

Psa 62:8 Trust in him at all times; ye people, pour out your heart before him: God is a refuge for us. Selah.

Mat 11:28 **Come unto me**, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and **I will give you rest.**

Mat 11:29 Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls.

Mat 11:30 For **my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.**

Luk 12:27 Consider the lilies how they grow: they toil not, they spin not; and yet I say unto you, that Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these.

Luk 12:28 If then God so clothe the grass, which is to day in the field, and to morrow is cast into the oven; **how much more will he clothe you, O ye of little faith?**

Psa 16:8 **I have set the LORD always before me:** because he is at my right hand, I shall not be moved.

Psa 37:23 **The steps of a good man are ordered by the LORD:** and he delighteth in his way.

Psa 37:24 Though he fall, he shall not be utterly cast down: for the LORD upholdeth him with his hand.

Psa 121:3 He will not suffer thy foot to be moved: **he that keepeth thee will not slumber.**

Psa 121:4 Behold, he that keepeth Israel shall neither slumber nor sleep.

Psa 121:5 **The LORD is thy keeper:** the LORD is thy shade upon thy right hand.

Psa 121:6 The sun shall not smite thee by day, nor

the moon by night.

Psa 121:7 **The LORD shall preserve thee from all evil: he shall preserve thy soul.**

Psa 121:8 **The LORD shall preserve thy going out and thy coming in from this time forth, and even for evermore.**

Psa 127:2 **It is vain for you to rise up early, to sit up late, to eat the bread of sorrows: for so he giveth his beloved sleep.**

1Sa 2:8 **He raiseth up the poor out of the dust, and lifteth up the beggar from the dunghill, to set them among princes, and to make them inherit the throne of glory: for the pillars of the earth are the LORD'S, and he hath set the world upon them.**

1Sa 2:9 **He will keep the feet of his saints, and the wicked shall be silent in darkness; for by strength shall no man prevail.**

Joh 10:27 My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me:

Joh 10:29 My Father, which gave them me, is greater than all; and **no man is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand.**

Pro 16:3 Commit thy works unto the LORD, and **thy thoughts shall be established.**
