

Fathers, Train Your Children

Pro 22:6 Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it.

Isa 38:19 The living, the living, he shall praise thee, as I do this day: the father to the children shall make known thy truth.

Psa71:18 Now also when I am old and grayheaded, O God, forsake me not; until I have shewed thy strength unto this generation, and thy power to every one that is to come.

Eph6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.

Deu 6:5 And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.

Deu 6:6 And these words, which I command thee this day, shall be in thine heart:

Deu 6:7 And thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children, and shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down, and when thou risest up.

Deu 11:19 And ye shall teach them your children, speaking of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, when thou liest down, and when thou risest up.

Jos 24:15 And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: **but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.**

Psa 78:3 Which **we have heard and known, and our fathers have told us.**

Psa 78:4 **We will not hide them from their children, shewing to the generation to come the praises of the LORD, and his strength, and his wonderful works that he hath done.**

Psa 78:5 For he established a testimony in Jacob, and appointed a law in Israel, which **he commanded our fathers, that they should make them known to their children:**

Psa 78:6 **That the generation to come might know them,** even the children which should be born; who should arise and declare them to their children:

Psa 78:7 That they might set their hope in God, and not forget the works of God, but keep his commandments:

Psa 145:3 Great is the LORD, and greatly to be praised; and his greatness is unsearchable.

Psa 145:4 **One generation shall praise thy works to another,** and shall declare thy mighty acts.

Psa 145:5 I will speak of the glorious honour of thy majesty, and of thy wondrous works.

Deu 11:18 Therefore shall ye lay up these my words in your heart and in your soul, and bind them for a sign upon your hand, that they may be as frontlets between your eyes.

Deu 11:19 **And ye shall teach them your children, speaking of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, when thou liest down, and when thou risest up.**

Deu 11:20 And thou shalt write them upon the door posts of thine house, and upon thy gates:

Deu 11:21 That your days may be multiplied, and the days of your children, in the land which the LORD sware unto your fathers to give them, as the days of heaven upon the earth.

Exo 13:8 **And thou shalt shew thy son in that day, saying,** This is done because of that which the LORD did unto me when I came forth out of Egypt.

Exo_ 3:14 **And it shall be when thy son asketh thee in time to come, saying, What is this? that thou shalt say unto him,** By strength of hand the LORD brought us out from Egypt, from the house of bondage:

1Ch 29:18 O LORD God of Abraham, Isaac, and of Israel, our fathers, keep this for ever in the imagination of the thoughts of the heart of thy people, and prepare their heart unto thee:

1Ch 29:19 **And give unto Solomon my son a perfect heart,** to keep thy commandments, thy testimonies, and thy statutes, and to do all these things, and to build the palace, for the which I have made provision.

1Ch 29:23 **Then Solomon sat on the throne of the LORD as king instead of David his father, and prospered;** and all Israel obeyed him.

1Ch 28:20 And **David said to Solomon his son**, Be strong and of good courage, and do it: fear not, nor be dismayed: for the LORD God, even my God, will be with thee; he will not fail thee, nor forsake thee, until thou hast finished all the work for the service of the house of the LORD.

Gen 18:17 And the LORD said, Shall I hide from Abraham that thing which I do;

Gen 18:18 Seeing that Abraham shall surely become a great and mighty nation, and all the nations of the earth shall be blessed in him?

Gen 18:19 **For I know him, that he will command his children and his household after him, and they shall keep the way of the LORD**, to do justice and judgment; that the LORD may bring upon Abraham that which he hath spoken of him.

Isa 38:19 The living, the living, he shall praise thee, as I do this day: **the father to the children shall make known thy truth.**

Eph 6:4 And, **ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath**: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.

Psa 48:13 Mark ye well her bulwarks, consider her palaces; that **ye may tell it to the generation following.**

Psa 48:14 For this God is our God for ever and ever: he will be our guide even unto death.

Psa 102:17 He will regard the prayer of the destitute, and not despise their prayer.

Psa 102:18 This shall be written for the generation to come: and the people which shall be created shall praise the LORD.

Psa 90:16 Let thy work appear unto thy servants, and **thy glory unto their children.**

Deu 4:9 Only take heed to thyself, and keep thy soul diligently, lest thou forget the things which thine eyes have seen, and lest they depart from thy heart all the days of thy life: **but teach them thy sons, and thy sons' sons;**

Deu4:10 Specially the day that thou stoodest before the LORD thy God in Horeb, when the LORD said unto me, Gather me the people together, and I will make them hear my words, that they may learn to fear me all the days that they shall live upon the earth, and **that they may teach their children.**

Joe 1:2 **Hear this, ye old men, and give ear,** all ye inhabitants of the land. Hath this been in your days, or even in the days of your fathers?

Joe 1:3 **Tell ye your children of it, and let your children tell their children, and their children another generation.**

Exo 10:2 And **that thou mayest tell in the ears of thy son, and of thy son's son,** what things I have wrought in Egypt, and my signs which I have done among them; that ye may know how that I am the LORD.

(spanking, not child abuse)

Eph 6:4 And, ye fathers, **provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.**

Pro 19:18 **Chasten thy son while there is hope,** and let not thy soul spare for his crying.

Pro 22:15 Foolishness is bound in the heart of a child; but the rod of correction shall drive it far from him.

Pro 29:15 The rod and reproof give wisdom: but a child left to himself bringeth his mother to shame.

Pro 29:17 Correct thy son, and he shall give thee rest; yea, he shall give delight unto thy soul.

Heb 12:8 But if ye be without chastisement, whereof all are partakers, then are ye bastards, and not sons.

Heb 12:9 Furthermore we have had fathers of our flesh which corrected us, and we gave them reverence: shall we not much rather be in subjection unto the Father of spirits, and live?

Heb 12:10 For they verily for a few days chastened us after their own pleasure; but he for our profit, that we might be partakers of his holiness.

Heb 12:11 Now no chastening for the present seemeth to be joyous, but grievous: nevertheless afterward it yieldeth the peaceable fruit of righteousness unto them which are exercised thereby.
