Psa 30:5 For his anger endureth but a moment; **in his favour is life**: weeping may endure for a night, but joy cometh in the morning.

Pro 8:35 For whoso findeth me findeth life, and **shall obtain favour of the LORD.**

Pro 12:2 **A good man obtaineth favour of the LORD**: but a man of wicked devices will he condemn.

Psa 5:12 For thou, LORD, wilt bless the righteous; **with favour wilt thou compass him as with a shield.**

Psa 44:3 For they got not the land in possession by their own sword, **neither did their own arm save them**: but thy right hand, and thine arm, and the light of thy countenance, **because thou hadst a favour unto them.**

Pro 16:15 In the light of the king's countenance is life; and **his favour is as a cloud of the latter rain.**

Pro 19:12 The king's wrath is as the roaring of a lion; but **his favour is as dew upon the grass.**

Eph 1:6 To the praise of the glory of his grace, wherein he hath made us **accepted** in the beloved.
