

# He Hears The Cry Of The Poor

Psa 69:29 But I am poor and sorrowful: let thy salvation, O God, set me up on high.

Psa\_69:33 **For the LORD heareth the poor, and despiseth not his prisoners.**

Psa 34:6 **This poor man cried, and the LORD heard him, and saved him out of all his troubles.**

Psa 72:4 He shall judge the poor of the people, **he shall save the children of the needy,** and shall break in pieces the oppressor.

Psa 72:12 For **he shall deliver the needy when he crieth; the poor also, and him that hath no helper.**

Psa 72:13 **He shall spare the poor and needy, and shall save the souls of the needy.**

Psa 72:14 He shall redeem their soul from deceit and violence: and precious shall their blood be in his sight.

Psa 102:17 **He will regard the prayer of the destitute, and not despise their prayer.**

Psa 10:14 Thou hast seen it; for thou beholdest mischief and spite, to requite it with thy hand: **the poor committeth himself unto thee; thou art the helper of the fatherless.**

Psa 9:18 **For the needy shall not always be forgotten: the expectation of the poor shall not perish for ever.**

James 2:5 Hearken, my beloved brethren, **Hath not God chosen the poor of this world rich in faith, and heirs of the kingdom** which he hath promised to them that love him?

James 2:6 But ye have despised the poor. Do not rich men oppress you, and draw you before the judgment seats?

Psa 3:1 A Psalm of David, when he fled from Absalom his son. LORD, how are they increased that trouble me! many are they that rise up against me.

Psa 3:2 Many there be which say of my soul, There is no help for him in God. Selah.

Psa 3:3 **But thou, O LORD, art a shield for me;** my glory, and the lifter up of mine head.

Psa 3:4 **I cried unto the LORD with my voice, and he heard me out of his holy hill.** Selah.

Psa 40:17 But I am poor and needy; yet the Lord thinketh upon me: **thou art my help and my deliverer;** make no tarrying, O my God.

Psa 34:17 The righteous cry, and **the LORD heareth, and delivereth them out of all their troubles.**

Psa 34:18 The LORD is nigh unto them that are of a broken heart; and saveth such as be of a contrite spirit.

Psa 34:19 Many are the afflictions of the righteous: **but the LORD delivereth him out of them all.**

Job 29:12 **Because I delivered the poor that cried, and the fatherless, and him that had none to help him.**

Isa 41:17 When the poor and needy seek water, and there is none, and their tongue faileth for thirst, **I the LORD will hear them, I the God of Israel will not forsake them.**

2Co 8:9 For ye know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that, though he was rich, **yet for your sakes he became poor, that ye through his poverty might be rich.**

Heb 7:25 Wherefore **he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God** by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them.

Psa 140:12 **I know that the LORD will maintain the cause of the afflicted, and the right of the poor.**

Psa 109:31 For **he shall stand at the right hand of the poor, to save him** from those that condemn his soul.

Job 5:15 But **he saveth the poor from the sword, from their mouth, and from the hand of the mighty.**

Job 5:16 **So the poor hath hope,** and iniquity stoppeth her mouth.

Eze 34:15 **I will feed my flock, and I will cause them to lie down,** saith the Lord GOD.

Eze 34:16 **I will seek that which was lost, and bring again that which was driven away, and will bind up that which was broken, and will strengthen that which was sick:** but I will destroy the fat and the strong; I will feed them with judgment.

Psa 22:24 For he hath not despised nor abhorred the affliction of the afflicted; neither hath he hid his face from him; **but when he cried unto him, he heard.**

Psa 55:22 Cast thy burden upon the LORD, and **he shall sustain thee**: he shall never suffer the righteous to be moved.

2Ti 1:12 For the which cause I also suffer these things: nevertheless I am not ashamed: for **I know whom I have believed, and am persuaded that he is able to keep that which I have committed unto him against that day.**

1Pe 5:6 Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, that he may exalt you in due time:

1Pe 5:7 **Casting all your care upon him; for he careth for you.**

Zep 3:12 I will also leave in the midst of thee an afflicted and poor people, and **they shall trust in the name of the LORD.**

Pro 8:17 I love them that love me; and those that seek me early shall find me.

Pro 8:18 **Riches and honour are with me; yea, durable riches and righteousness.**

Pro 8:19 **My fruit is better than gold, yea, than fine gold; and my revenue than choice silver.**

Pro 8:21 **That I may cause those that love me to inherit substance; and I will fill their treasures.**

Isa 50:7 For the Lord GOD will help me; therefore shall I not be confounded: therefore have I set my face like a flint, and **I know that I shall not be ashamed. (disappointed)**

Heb 13:5 Let your conversation be without covetousness; and **be content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.**

Heb 13:6 So that we may boldly say, **The Lord is my helper, and I will not fear what man shall do unto me.**

Psa 121:7 **The LORD shall preserve thee from all evil: he shall preserve thy soul.**

Psa 121:8 **The LORD shall preserve thy going out and thy coming in from this time forth, and even for evermore.**

Psa 107:41 **Yet setteth he the poor on high from affliction, and maketh him families like a flock.**

1Sa 2:8 **He raiseth up the poor out of the dust, and lifteth up the beggar from the dunghill, to set them among princes, and to make them inherit the throne of glory: for the pillars of the earth are the LORD'S, and he hath set the world upon them.**

Eze 34:11 For thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, **I, even I, will both search my sheep, and seek them out.**

Isa 40:11 **He shall feed his flock like a shepherd: he shall gather the lambs with his arm, and carry them in his bosom, and shall gently lead those that are with young.**

*Jesus-*

Luk\_4:18 The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me **to preach the gospel to the poor;** he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised,

Luk 6:20 And he lifted up his eyes on his disciples, and said,  
**Blessed be ye poor: for yours is the kingdom of God.**

Luk 6:21 **Blessed are ye that hunger now: for ye shall be filled.  
Blessed are ye that weep now: for ye shall laugh.**

Mat 18:10 Take heed that ye despise not one of these little ones; for I say unto you, That in heaven their angels do always behold the face of my Father which is in heaven.

Mat 18:11 For **the Son of man is come to save that which was lost.**

Mat 18:12 How think ye? if a man have an hundred sheep, and one of them be gone astray, doth he not leave the ninety and nine, and goeth into the mountains, and seeketh that which is gone astray?

Mat 18:13 And if so be that he find it, verily I say unto you, he rejoiceth more of that sheep, than of the ninety and nine which went not astray.

Mat 18:14 Even so **it is not the will of your Father which is in heaven, that one of these little ones should perish.**

Rev 3:17 Because thou sayest, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing; and knowest not that thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked:

Rev 3:18 **I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich; and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed,** and that the shame of thy nakedness do not appear; and anoint thine eyes with eyesalve, that thou mayest see.

Mat 11:5 The blind receive their sight, and the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, and the deaf hear, the dead are raised up, and **the poor have the gospel preached to them.**

Isa 61:1 The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound;

Isa 61:2 To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all that mourn;

Isa 61:3 To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that he might be glorified.
