

I am not Ashamed

Mat 10:32 Whosoever therefore shall confess me before men, him will I confess also before my Father which is in heaven.

Psa 119:46 I will speak of thy testimonies also before kings, and will not be ashamed.

Isa 51:7 Hearken unto me, ye that know righteousness, the people in whose heart is my law; fear ye not the reproach of men, neither be ye afraid of their revilings.

Isa 51:12 I, even I, am he that comforteth you: who art thou, that thou shouldest be afraid of a man that shall die, and of the son of man which shall be made as grass;

Mar 8:38 Whosoever therefore shall be ashamed of me and of my words in this adulterous and sinful generation; of him also shall the Son of man be ashamed, when he cometh in the glory of his Father with the holy angels.

Luk 12:8 Also I say unto you, Whosoever shall confess me before men, him shall the Son of man also confess before the angels of God:

Luk 12:9 But he that denieth me before men shall be denied before the angels of God.

Rom 10:9 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.

Rom 10:10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

1Ti 6:12 Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold on eternal life, whereunto thou art also called, and **hast professed a good profession before many witnesses.**

2Ti 1:7 For **God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.**

2Ti 1:8 **Be not thou therefore ashamed of the testimony of our Lord,** nor of me his prisoner: but be thou partaker of the afflictions of the gospel according to the power of God;

2Ti 1:12 For the which cause I also suffer these things: **nevertheless I am not ashamed: for I know whom I have believed,** and am persuaded that he is able to keep that which I have committed unto him against that day.

1Jn 4:15 **Whosoever shall confess that Jesus is the Son of God, God dwelleth in him, and he in God.**

Jer 1:17 Thou therefore gird up thy loins, and arise, and speak unto them all that I command thee: **be not dismayed at their faces,** lest I confound thee before them.

Eze 2:6 And thou, son of man, **be not afraid of them, neither be afraid of their words,** though briars and thorns be with thee, and thou dost dwell among scorpions: **be not afraid of their words, nor be dismayed at their looks, though they be a rebellious house.**

Eze 3:9 As an adamant harder than flint have I made thy forehead: **fear them not, neither be dismayed at their looks**, though they be a rebellious house.

Act 5:40 And to him they agreed: and when they had called the apostles, and beaten them, **they commanded that they should not speak in the name of Jesus, and let them go.**

Act 5:41 And they departed from the presence of the council, rejoicing that they were counted worthy to suffer shame for his name.

Act 5:42 And daily in the temple, and in every house, **they ceased not to teach and preach Jesus Christ.**

Rom 1:16 For **I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ:** for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.

Rom 9:33 As it is written, Behold, I lay in Sion a stumblingstone and rock of offence: and **whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed.**

1Pe 4:14 **If ye be reproached for the name of Christ, happy are ye; for the spirit of glory and of God resteth upon you:** on their part he is evil spoken of, but on your part he is glorified.

1Pe 4:16 Yet **if any man suffer as a Christian, let him not be ashamed;** but let him glorify God on this behalf.

2Ti 2:3 Thou therefore **endure hardness, as a good soldier** of Jesus Christ.

2Ti 2:11 It is a faithful saying: For if we be dead with him, we shall also live with him:

2Ti 2:12 If we suffer, we shall also reign with him: if we deny him, he also will deny us:

Rev 12:11 And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.

Mat 10:18 And ye shall be brought before governors and kings for my sake, for a testimony against them and the Gentiles.

Mat 10:19 But when they deliver you up, **take no thought how or what ye shall speak: for it shall be given you in that same hour what ye shall speak.**

Mat 10:20 For it is not ye that speak, but the Spirit of your Father which speaketh in you.

Mat 10:21 And the brother shall deliver up the brother to death, and the father the child: and the children shall rise up against their parents, and cause them to be put to death.

Mat 10:22 And **ye shall be hated of all men for my name's sake:** but he that endureth to the end shall be saved.

Dan 3:16 Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, answered and said to the king, O Nebuchadnezzar, we are not careful to answer thee in this matter.

Dan 3:17 If it be so, our God whom we serve is able to deliver us from the burning fiery furnace, and he will deliver us out of thine hand, O king.

Dan 3:18 But if not, be it known unto thee, **O king, that we will not serve thy gods, nor worship the golden image which thou hast set up.**

Php 1:20 According to my earnest expectation and my hope, that **in nothing I shall be ashamed, but that with all boldness, as always,** so now also Christ shall be magnified in my body, whether it be by life, or by death.

Php 1:21 **For to me to live is Christ, and to die is gain.**

1Jn 2:28 And now, little children, **abide in him; that, when he shall appear, we may have confidence, and not be ashamed before him at his coming.**

Mat 5:10 **Blessed are they which are persecuted for righteousness' sake:** for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

Mat 5:11 **Blessed are ye, when men shall revile you, and persecute you, and shall say all manner of evil against you falsely, for my sake.**

Mat 5:12 **Rejoice, and be exceeding glad: for great is your reward in heaven: for so persecuted they the prophets which were before you.**

Mat 10:27 **What I tell you in darkness, that speak ye in light:** and what ye hear in the ear, that **preach ye upon the housetops.**

Mat 10:28 And **fear not them which kill the body,** but are not able to kill the soul: but rather **fear him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.**

Luk 6:22 **Blessed are ye, when men shall hate you,** and when they shall separate you from their company, and shall reproach you, and cast out your name as evil, for the Son of man's sake.

Luk 6:23 **Rejoice ye in that day, and leap for joy: for, behold, your reward is great in heaven: for in the like manner did their fathers unto the prophets.**

Heb 11:25 Choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God, than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a season;

Heb 11:26 **Esteeming the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures in Egypt:** for he had respect unto the recompence of the reward.

Heb 12:1 Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, **let us lay aside every weight,** and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us,

Heb 12:2 **Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame,** and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.

Heb 12:3 For **consider him** that endured such contradiction of sinners against himself, lest ye be wearied and faint in your minds.

Heb 12:4 **Ye have not yet resisted unto blood,** striving against sin.

Rev 12:11 **And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.**

Rev 6:9 And when he had opened the fifth seal, **I saw under the altar the souls of them that were slain for the word of God, and for the testimony which they held:**

Act 4:18 And they called them, and **commanded them not to speak at all nor teach in the name of Jesus.**

Act 4:19 But Peter and John answered and said unto them, Whether it be right in the sight of God to hearken unto you more than unto God, judge ye.

Act 4:20 For we cannot but speak the things which we have seen and heard.

Act 4:29 And now, Lord, **behold their threatenings: and grant unto thy servants, that with all boldness they may speak thy word,**

Eph 6:18 **Praying always** with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;

Eph 6:19 And for me, **that utterance may be given unto me, that I may open my mouth boldly, to make known the mystery of the gospel,**
