

## **Jesus = God**

Heb 1:8 But **unto the Son he saith, Thy throne, O God**, is for ever and ever: a sceptre of righteousness is the sceptre of thy kingdom.

Isa 9:6 For **unto us a child is born**, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and **his name shall be called** Wonderful, Counsellor, **The mighty God, The everlasting Father**, The Prince of Peace.

Isa 7:14 Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign; **Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel.**

*Immanuel = "God with us" or "with us is God"*

Mat 1:23 Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and **they shall call his name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us.**

Joh 10:30 **I and my Father are one.**

Joh 20:27 Then saith he to Thomas, Reach hither thy finger, and behold my hands; and reach hither thy hand, and thrust it into my side: and be not faithless, but believing.

Joh 20:28 And **Thomas answered and said unto him, My Lord and my God.**

1Ti 2:5 For **there is one God**, and one mediator between God and men, **the man Christ Jesus;**

1Ti 3:16 And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: **God was manifest in the flesh**, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory.

1Jn 5:20 And we know that the Son of God is come, and hath given us an understanding, that we may know him that is true, and we are in him that is true, **even in his Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God, and eternal life.**

Joh 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and **the Word was God.**

Joh 1:14 And **the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us**, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.

1Jn 5:7 For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and **these three are one.**

Act 20:28 Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost hath made you overseers, **to feed the church of God, which he hath purchased with his own blood.**

Rom 9:5 Whose are the fathers, and of whom as concerning the flesh **Christ came, who is over all, God** blessed for ever. Amen.

1Co 15:47 The first man is of the earth, earthy: **the second man is the Lord from heaven.**

Php\_2:6 Who, **being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God:**

Php 2:7 But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men:

Col 2:9 For **in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily.**

Rev 1:17 And when I saw him, I fell at his feet as dead. And he laid his right hand upon me, saying unto me, Fear not; **I am the first and the last:**

Rev 1:18 **I am he that liveth, and was dead;** and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have the keys of hell and of death.

Rev 21:6 And he said unto me, It is done. **I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end.** I will give unto him that is athirst of the fountain of the water of life freely.

Rev 21:7 He that overcometh shall inherit all things; and **I will be his God,** and he shall be my son.

Joh 8:58 Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, **Before Abraham was, I am.**

Exo 3:14 And **God said unto Moses, I AM THAT I AM:** and he said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, **I AM hath sent me unto you.**

Joh 14:7 **If ye had known me, ye should have known my Father also: and from henceforth ye know him, and have seen him.**

Joh 14:8 Philip saith unto him, Lord, **shew us the Father**, and it sufficeth us.

Joh 14:9 Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? **he that hath seen me hath seen the Father;** and how sayest thou then, Shew us the Father?

Joh 8:19 Then said they unto him, Where is thy Father? Jesus answered, **Ye neither know me, nor my Father: if ye had known me, ye should have known my Father also.**

Heb 1:3 Who being the brightness of his glory, and **the express image of his person**, and upholding all things by the word of his power, when he had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high;

Isa 45:21 Tell ye, and bring them near; yea, let them take counsel together: who hath declared this from ancient time? who hath told it from that time? have not I the LORD? and **there is no God else beside me; a just God and a Saviour; there is none beside me.**

Isa 45:22 Look unto me, and be ye saved, all the ends of the earth: for **I am God, and there is none else.**

Isa 45:23 I have sworn by myself, the word is gone out of my mouth in righteousness, and shall not return, That **unto me every knee shall bow, every tongue shall swear.**

*tied to in the new testament*

Php 2:10 That **at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth;**

Joh 5:18 Therefore the Jews sought the more to kill him, because he not only had broken the sabbath, **but said also that God was his Father, making himself equal with God.**

Joh 8:23 And he said unto them, **Ye are from beneath; I am from above: ye are of this world; I am not of this world.**

Joh 8:24 I said therefore unto you, that ye shall die in your sins: for if ye believe not that I am he, ye shall die in your sins.

Heb 13:8 **Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.**

Heb 2:14 Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, **he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil;**

2Co 5:19 To wit, that **God was in Christ**, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation.

Mar 2:5 When Jesus saw their faith, he said unto the sick of the palsy, **Son, thy sins be forgiven thee.**

Mar 2:7 Why doth this man thus speak blasphemies? **who can forgive sins but God only?**

Act 9:5 And he said, **Who art thou, Lord? And the Lord said, I am Jesus** whom thou persecutest: it is hard for thee to kick against the pricks.

## ***Jesus is Worshiped:***

*Jesus said:*

Mat 4:10 Then saith Jesus unto him, Get thee hence, Satan: for it is written, **Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.**

**Yet did not rebuke those who worshiped Him,**

Mat 2:2 Saying, Where is he that is born King of the Jews? for we have seen his star in the east, and **are come to worship him.**

Mat 2:11 And when they were come into the house, they saw the young child with Mary his mother, and **fell down, and worshipped him:** and when they had opened their treasures, they presented unto him gifts; gold, and frankincense, and myrrh.

Mat 14:33 **Then they that were in the ship came and worshipped him,** saying, Of a truth thou art the Son of God.

Mat 28:9 And as they went to tell his disciples, behold, Jesus met them, saying, All hail. And they came and held him by the feet, **and worshipped him.**

Joh 9:37 And Jesus said unto him, Thou hast both seen him, and it is he that talketh with thee.

Joh 9:38 And he said, Lord, I believe. **And he worshipped him.**

Heb 1:5 For unto which of the angels said he at any time, Thou art my Son, this day have I begotten thee? And again, I will be to him a Father, and he shall be to me a Son?

Heb 1:6 And again, when he bringeth in the firstbegotten into the world, he saith, **And let all the angels of God worship him.**

Rev 5:12 Saying with a loud voice, **Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honour, and glory, and blessing.**

Rev 5:13 And every creature which is in heaven, and on the earth, and under the earth, and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, heard I saying, **Blessing, and honour, and glory, and power, be unto him that sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb for ever and ever.**

Rev 5:14 And the four beasts said, Amen. And the four and twenty elders **fell down and worshipped him that liveth for ever and ever.**

## **Creator:**

Isa 45:18 For thus saith the LORD that created the heavens; **God himself that formed the earth and made it; he hath established it, he created it not in vain, he formed it to be inhabited: I am the LORD; and there is none else.**

Col 1:13 Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the **kingdom of his dear Son:**

Col 1:14 In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins:

Col 1:15 **Who is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of**

every creature:

**Col 1:16 For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him:**

**Col 1:17 And he is before all things, and by him all things consist.**

**1Co 8:6 But to us there is but one God, the Father, of whom are all things, and we in him; and one Lord Jesus Christ, by whom are all things, and we by him.**

**Joh 1:3 All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made.**

**Joh 1:10 He was in the world, and the world was made by him, and the world knew him not.**

**Heb 3:4 For every house is builded by some man; but he that built all things is God.**

**Eph 3:9 And to make all men see what is the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in God, who created all things by Jesus Christ:**

**Heb 1:2 Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds;**

## No Savior but God!

Hos 13:4 Yet I am the LORD thy God from the land of Egypt, and thou shalt know no god but me: for **there is no saviour beside me.**

Isa 43:11 I, even I, am the LORD; and **beside me there is no saviour.**

Isa 45:21 Tell ye, and bring them near; yea, let them take counsel together: who hath declared this from ancient time? who hath told it from that time? have not I the LORD? and **there is no God else beside me; a just God and a Saviour;** there is none beside me.

Isa 45:22 **Look unto me, and be ye saved, all the ends of the earth: for I am God, and there is none else.**

Act 4:10 Be it known unto you all, and to all the people of Israel, that **by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth,** whom ye crucified, whom God raised from the dead, even by him doth this man stand here before you whole.

Act 4:12 **Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.**
