Isa 12:3 **Therefore with joy shall ye draw water out of the wells of salvation.**

Neh 8:10 Then he said unto them, Go your way, eat the fat, and drink the sweet, and send portions unto them for whom nothing is prepared: for this day is holy unto our Lord: neither be ye sorry; for **the joy of the LORD is your strength.**

Psa 5:11 **But let all those that put their trust in thee rejoice: let them ever shout for joy,** because thou defendest them: let them also that love thy name be joyful in thee.

Psa 5:12 For thou, LORD, wilt bless the righteous; with favour wilt thou compass him as with a shield.

Psa 13:5 But I have trusted in thy mercy; **my heart shall rejoice in thy salvation.**

Psa 13:6 **I will sing** unto the LORD, because he hath dealt bountifully with me.

Psa 16:8 I have set the LORD always before me: because he is at my right hand, I shall not be moved.

Psa 16:9 **Therefore my heart is glad, and my glory rejoiceth: my flesh also shall rest in hope.**

Psa 16:10 For thou wilt not leave my soul in hell; neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption.

Psa 16:11 Thou wilt shew me the path of life: **in thy presence is fulness of joy; at thy right hand there are pleasures for evermore.**

Psa 28:7 The LORD is my strength and my shield; my heart trusted in him, and I am helped: **therefore my heart greatly rejoiceth;** and with my song will I praise him.

Psa 30:5 For his anger endureth but a moment; in his favour is life: weeping may endure for a night, **but joy cometh in the morning.**

Psa 30:11 **Thou hast turned for me my mourning into dancing:** thou hast put off my sackcloth, and girded me with gladness;

Psa 32:9 **Be ye not as the horse, or as the mule,** which have no understanding: whose mouth must be held in with bit and bridle, lest they come near unto thee.

Psa 32:10 Many sorrows shall be to the wicked: but he that trusteth in the LORD, mercy shall compass him about.

Psa 32:11 **Be glad in the LORD, and rejoice, ye righteous: and shout for joy,** all ye that are upright in heart.

Psa 33:21 **For our heart shall rejoice in him,** because we have trusted in his holy name.

Psa 35:9 And **my soul shall be joyful in the LORD: it shall rejoice in his salvation.**

Psa 40:16 **Let all those that seek thee rejoice and be glad in thee:** let such as love thy salvation say continually, The LORD be magnified.

Psa 36:8 They shall be **abundantly satisfied** with the fatness of thy house; and **thou shalt make them drink of the river of thy pleasures.**

Psa 42:4 When I remember these things, I pour out my soul in me: for I had gone with the multitude, I went with them to the house of God, with the voice of joy and praise, with a multitude that kept holyday.

Psa 42:5 **Why art thou cast down, O my soul? and why art thou disquieted in me? hope thou in God: for I shall yet praise him for the help of his countenance.**

Psa 43:4 Then will I go unto the altar of God, unto God my exceeding joy: yea, upon the harp will I praise thee, O God my God.

Psa 43:5 Why art thou cast down, O my soul? and why art thou disquieted within me? hope in God: for **I shall yet praise him**, who is the health of my countenance, and my God.

Psa 46:2 Therefore will not we fear, **though the earth be removed, and though the mountains be carried into the midst of the sea;**

Psa 46:3 **Though the waters thereof roar and be troubled, though the mountains shake with the swelling thereof.** Selah.

Psa 46:4 **There is a river, the streams whereof shall make glad the city of God**, the holy place of the tabernacles of the most High.

Psa 46:5 God is in the midst of her; she shall not be moved: God shall help her, and that right early.

Psa 51:12 **Restore unto me the joy of thy salvation;** and uphold me with thy free spirit.

Psa 63:5 My soul shall be satisfied as with marrow and fatness; and **my mouth shall praise thee with joyful lips:**

Psa 64:10 The **righteous shall be glad in the LORD**, and shall trust in him; and all the upright in heart shall glory.

Psa 68:3 But let the righteous be glad; **let them rejoice before God: yea, let them exceedingly rejoice.**

Psa_68:4 Sing unto God, sing praises to his name: extol him that rideth upon the heavens by his name JAH, and rejoice before him.

Psa 71:23 **My lips shall greatly rejoice when I sing unto thee;** and my soul, which thou hast redeemed.

Psa 89:15 **Blessed is the people that know the joyful sound:** they shall walk, O LORD, in the light of thy countenance.

Psa 89:16 **In thy name shall they rejoice all the day:** and in thy righteousness shall they be exalted.

Psa 89:17 For thou art the glory of their strength: and in thy favour our horn shall be exalted.

Psa 89:18 For the LORD is our defence; and the Holy One of Israel is our king.

Psa 100:1 A Psalm of praise. **Make a joyful noise unto the LORD,** all ye lands.

Psa 100:2 Serve the LORD with gladness: come before his presence with singing.

Psa 100:3 Know ye that the LORD he is God: it is he that hath made us, and not we ourselves; we are his people, and the sheep of his pasture.

Psa 100:4 Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name.

Psa 100:5 For the LORD is good; his mercy is everlasting; and his truth endureth to all generations.

Psa 104:33 I will sing unto the LORD as long as I live: I will sing praise to my God while I have my being.

Psa 104:34 My meditation of him shall be sweet: I will be glad in the LORD.

Psa 105:3 Glory ye in his holy name: let the heart of them rejoice that seek the LORD.

Psa 119:14 I have rejoiced in the way of thy testimonies, as much as in all riches.

Psa 119:162 I rejoice at thy word, as one that findeth great spoil.

Psa 149:5 Let the saints be joyful in glory: let them sing aloud upon their beds.

Psa 149:6 Let the high praises of God be in their mouth, and a twoedged sword in their hand;

Psa 126:5 They that sow in tears shall reap in joy.

Psa 126:6 He that goeth forth and weepeth, bearing precious seed, shall doubtless come again with rejoicing, bringing his sheaves with him.

Isa 35:10 And the ransomed of the LORD shall return, and come to Zion with songs and everlasting joy upon their heads: they shall obtain joy and gladness, and sorrow and sighing shall flee away.

Isa 51:11 Therefore the redeemed of the LORD shall return, and come with singing unto Zion; and everlasting joy shall be upon

their head: they shall obtain gladness and joy; and sorrow and mourning shall flee away.

Isa 61:3 To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, **the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness**; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that he might be glorified.

Isa 61:7 For your shame ye shall have double; and for confusion they shall rejoice in their portion: therefore in their land they shall possess the double: **everlasting joy shall be unto them.**

Isa 61:10 **I will greatly rejoice in the LORD, my soul shall be joyful in my God**; for he hath clothed me with the garments of salvation, he hath covered me with the robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom decketh himself with ornaments, and as a bride adorneth herself with her jewels.

Jer 15:16 Thy words were found, and I did eat them; and **thy word was unto me the joy and rejoicing of mine heart**: for I am called by thy name, O LORD God of hosts.

Jer 31:13 Then shall the virgin rejoice in the dance, both young men and old together: for **I will turn their mourning into joy, and will comfort them, and make them rejoice from their sorrow.**

Jer 33:11 **The voice of joy, and the voice of gladness**, the voice of the bridegroom, and the voice of the bride, the voice of them that shall say, Praise the LORD of hosts: for the LORD is good; for his mercy endureth for ever: and of them that shall bring the sacrifice of praise into the house of the LORD. For I will cause to return the captivity of the land, as at the first, saith the LORD.

Hab 3:17 **Although the fig tree shall not blossom**, neither shall fruit be in the vines; the labour of the olive shall fail, and the fields shall yield no meat; the flock shall be cut off from the fold, and there shall be no herd in the stalls:

Hab 3:18 **Yet I will rejoice in the LORD, I will joy in the God of my salvation.**

Hab 3:19 The LORD God is my strength, and he will make my feet like hinds' feet, and he will make me to walk upon mine high places. To the chief singer on my stringed instruments.

Luk 10:20 Notwithstanding in this rejoice not, that the spirits are subject unto you; **but rather rejoice, because your names are written in heaven.**

Joh 15:11 **These things have I spoken unto you, that my joy might remain in you, and that your joy might be full.**

Joh 16:22 And ye now therefore have sorrow: but I will see you again, and your heart shall rejoice, and **your joy no man taketh from you.**

Joh 16:23 And in that day ye shall ask me nothing. Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in my name, he will give it you.

Joh 16:24 Hitherto have ye asked nothing in my name: **ask, and ye shall receive, that your joy may be full.**

Joh 17:13 And now come I to thee; and these things I speak in the world, **that they might have my joy fulfilled in themselves.**

Act 13:52 And the disciples **were filled with joy, and with the Holy Ghost.**

Rom 14:17 For **the kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost.**

Gal 5:22 But **the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith,**

Eph 5:18 And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but **be filled with the Spirit;**

Eph 5:19 Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord;

Php 4:4 **Rejoice in the Lord alway:** and again I say, Rejoice.

Col 1:11 **Strengthened with all might,** according to his glorious power, unto all patience and longsuffering **with joyfulness;**

1Th 1:6 And ye became followers of us, and of the Lord, having received the word in much affliction, **with joy of the Holy Ghost:**

1Th 5:16 **Rejoice evermore.**

Jas 1:2 My brethren, **count it all joy** when ye fall into divers temptations;

1Pe 1:8 Whom having not seen, ye love; in whom, though now ye see him not, yet believing, **ye rejoice with joy unspeakable and full of glory:**

1Jn 1:3 That which we have seen and heard declare we unto you, that ye also may have fellowship with us: and truly our fellowship is with the Father, and with his Son Jesus Christ.

1Jn 1:4 And **these things write we unto you, that your joy may be full.**

Pro 10:28 **The hope of the righteous shall be gladness:** but the expectation of the wicked shall perish.

Pro 28:12 **When righteous men do rejoice, there is great glory:** but when the wicked rise, a man is hidden.

Pro 17:22 **A merry heart doeth good like a medicine:** but a broken spirit drieth the bones.

1Ch 16:27 Glory and honour are in his presence; **strength and gladness are in his place.**

Heb 12:2 Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; **who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross,** despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.

Pro 15:23 **A man hath joy by the answer of his mouth:** and a word spoken in due season, how good is it!
