

## **Just Ask!**

Joh 14:13 And **whatsoever ye shall ask** in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.

Joh 14:14 **If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it.**

Joh 15:7 If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, **ye shall ask what ye will,** and it shall be done unto you.

Joh 15:16 Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and that your fruit should remain: that **whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in my name, he may give it you.**

Mat 7:7 **Ask, and it shall be given you;** seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you:

Mat 21:22 And all things, **whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive.**

Mar 11:24 Therefore I say unto you, **What things soever ye desire**, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and **ye shall have them.**

Luk 11:9 And I say unto you, **Ask, and it shall be given you**; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you.

Eph 3:20 Now unto him that **is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think**, according to the power that worketh in us,

Jas 1:5 If any of you lack wisdom, **let him ask of God**, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and **it shall be given him.**

Jas 1:6 But let him **ask in faith, nothing wavering**. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed.

Jas 1:7 For let not that man think that he shall receive any thing of the Lord.

Jas 1:8 A double minded man is unstable in all his ways.

*2-more about doublemindedness:*

Jas 4:8 Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse your hands, ye sinners; and purify your hearts, ye double minded.

Mat 6:22 The light of the body is the eye: if therefore thine eye be single, thy whole body shall be full of light.

Jas 5:16 Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. **The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.**

1Jn 3:20 For if our heart condemn us, God is greater than our heart, and knoweth all things.

1Jn 3:21 Beloved, if our heart condemn us not, then have we confidence toward God.

1Jn 3:22 And **whatsoever we ask, we receive of him**, because we keep his commandments, and do those things that are pleasing in his sight.

*The next verse is the command:*

1Jn 3:23 And this is his commandment, That we should believe on the name of his Son Jesus Christ, and love one another, as he gave us commandment.

1Jn 5:14 And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, **if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us:**

1Jn 5:15 And if we know that he hear us, **whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him.**

Mat 6:8 Be not ye therefore like unto them: for your Father knoweth what things ye have need of, **before ye ask him.**

Mat 7:7 **Ask, and it shall be given you;** seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you:

Mat 7:8 **For every one that asketh receiveth;** and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.

Mat 7:9 Or what man is there of you, whom if his son ask bread, will he give him a stone?

Mat 7:10 Or if he ask a fish, will he give him a serpent?

Mat 7:11 If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children, **how much more shall your Father which is in heaven give good things to them that ask him?**

Mat 18:19 Again I say unto you, That **if two of you shall agree on earth as touching any thing that they shall ask, it shall be done for them** of my Father which is in heaven.

Mat 21:22 And **all things, whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive.**

Luk 11:9 And I say unto you, Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you.

Luk 11:10 For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.

Luk 11:11 If a son shall ask bread of any of you that is a father, will he give him a stone? or if he ask a fish, will he for a fish give him a serpent?

Luk 11:12 Or if he shall ask an egg, will he offer him a scorpion?

**Luk 11:13 If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: how much more shall your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to them that ask him?**

**Joh 14:14 If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it.**

**Joh 16:23 And in that day ye shall ask me nothing. Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in my name, he will give it you.**

**Joh 16:24 Hitherto have ye asked nothing in my name: ask, and ye shall receive, that your joy may be full.**

**Joh 16:26 At that day ye shall ask in my name: and I say not unto you, that I will pray the Father for you:**

Jas 4:3 **Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss,** that ye may consume it upon your lusts.

Joh 4:10 Jesus answered and said unto her, If thou knewest the gift of God, and who it is that saith to thee, Give me to drink; **thou wouldest have asked of him, and he would have given thee living water.**

Ecc 5:2 Be not rash with thy mouth, and let not thine heart be hasty to utter any thing before God: for God is in heaven, and thou upon earth: therefore let thy words be few.

Mat 6:7 But when ye pray, use not vain repetitions, as the heathen do: for they think that they shall be heard for their much speaking.
