1Co 7:23 **Ye are bought with a price**; be not ye the servants of men.

1Co 6:20 For **ye are bought with a price**: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.

Act 20:28 Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost hath made you overseers, to feed the church of God, which **he hath purchased with his own blood**.

1Pe 1:18 Forasmuch as ye know that **ye were not redeemed with corruptible things**, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers;

1Pe 1:19 **But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot**:

Mat 26:28 For **this is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins**.

Eph 1:7 In whom **we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins**, according to the riches of his grace;

Col 1:13 Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son:

Col 1:14 **In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins**:

Heb 9:12 **Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by his own blood he entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption for us.**

Heb 9:13 For if the blood of bulls and of goats, and the ashes of an heifer sprinkling the unclean, sanctifieth to the purifying of the flesh:

Heb 9:14 **How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?**

Heb 13:12 Wherefore Jesus also, that **he might sanctify the people with his own blood**, suffered without the gate.

Rev 1:5 And from Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness, and the first begotten of the dead, and the prince of the kings of the earth. **Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood,**

Rev 5:9 And they sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: **for thou wast slain, and hast redeemed us to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation;**

1Jn 1:7 But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and **the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.**

Rev 7:14 And I said unto him, Sir, thou knowest. And he said to me, These are they which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and **made them white in the blood of the Lamb.**

Rom 3:23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;
Rom 3:24 Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus:

Rom 3:25 Whom **God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood,** to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God;

Rom 5:6 For **when we were yet without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly.**

Rom 5:7 For scarcely for a righteous man will one die: yet peradventure for a good man some would even dare to die.

Rom 5:8 But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

Rom 5:9 **Much more then, being now justified by his blood,** we shall be saved from wrath through him.

1Pe 2:24 Who his own self **bare our sins in his own body on the tree,** that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: **by whose stripes ye were healed.**

Mat 20:28 Even as the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and **to give his life a ransom for many.**

Isa 53:4 Surely **he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows:** yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.

Isa 53:5 **But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.**

Isa 53:6 All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all.

Isa 53:7 **He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth.**

Isa 53:8 He was taken from prison and from judgment: and who shall declare his generation? for **he was cut off out of the land of the living: for the transgression of my people was he stricken.**

Isa 53:9 And he made his grave with the wicked, and with the rich in his death; because he had done no violence, neither was any deceit in his mouth.

Isa 53:10 Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise him; he hath put him to grief: **when thou shalt make his soul an offering for sin, he shall see his seed, he shall prolong his days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in his hand.**

Isa 53:11 He shall see of the travail of his soul, and shall be satisfied: **by his knowledge shall my righteous servant justify many; for he shall bear their iniquities.**

1Pe 3:18 **For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but quickened by the Spirit:**

1Co 15:3 For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, **how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures;**

1Co 15:4 And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures:

Tit 2:14 **Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity,** and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works.

Joh 1:29 The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, **Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.**

1Jn 2:1 My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous:

1Jn 2:2 **And he is the propitiation for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world.**

Heb 9:28 So **Christ was once offered to bear the sins of many;** and unto them that look for him shall he appear the second time without sin unto salvation.

Gal 3:13 **Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree:**

Gal 3:14 That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

Act 8:32 The place of the scripture which he read was this, **He was led as a sheep to the slaughter;** and like a lamb dumb before his shearer, so opened he not his mouth:

2Co 5:21 For **he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.**

Gal 1:4 **Who gave himself for our sins, that he might deliver us from this present evil world,** according to the will of God and our Father:

Eph 2:16 And that **he might reconcile both unto God in one body by the cross,** having slain the enmity thereby:

Eph 2:17 And came and preached peace to you which were afar off, and to them that were nigh.

Eph 2:18 For **through him we both have access by one Spirit unto the Father.**

Rom 4:24 But for us also, to whom it shall be imputed, if we believe on him that raised up Jesus our Lord from the dead;

Rom 4:25 **Who was delivered for our offences, and was raised again for our justification.**

Rom 8:11 But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, **he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies** by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.

Mat 20:28 Even as the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and **to give his life a ransom for many.**

Rom 8:32 **He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things?**

Heb 1:3 Who being the brightness of his glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power, **when he had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high;**

Heb 10:10 **By the which will we are sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.**

Heb 10:12 **But this man,** after he had offered **one sacrifice for sins for ever,** sat down on the right hand of God;

Heb 10:13 From henceforth expecting till his enemies be made his footstool.

Heb 10:14 **For by one offering he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified.**

Heb 10:15 Whereof the Holy Ghost also is a witness to us: for after that he had said before,

Heb 10:16 This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, **I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them;**

Heb 10:17 **And their sins and iniquities will I remember no more.**

1Ti 2:5 **For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;**

1Ti 2:6 **Who gave himself a ransom for all,** to be testified in due time.

1Jn 2:1 My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And **if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous:**

1Jn 2:2 **And he is the propitiation for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world.**

1Jn 4:10 Herein is love, **not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins.**

Isa 1:18 **Come now, and let us reason together, saith the LORD:** though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool.
