SET, YOUR LOVE

Psa 91:14 **Because he hath set his love upon me**, therefore will I deliver him: I will set him on high, because he hath known my name.

Psa 91:15 He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honour him.

Psa 91:16 With long life will I satisfy him, and shew him my salvation.

Joh 14:23 Jesus answered and said unto him, **If a man love me, he will keep my words: and my Father will love him, and we will come unto him, and make our abode with him.**

Joh 16:27 For **the Father himself loveth you, because ye have loved me**, and have believed that I came out from God

Col 3:1 If ye then be risen with Christ, **seek those things which are above**, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God.

Col 3:2 **Set your affection on things above**, not on things on the earth.

Col 3:3 For ye are dead, and your life is hid with Christ in God.

Act 11:23 Who, when he came, and had seen the grace of God, was glad, and exhorted them all, that **with purpose of heart they would cleave unto the Lord.**

Psa 130:5 I wait for the LORD, my soul doth wait, and in his word do I hope.

Psa 63:5 My soul shall be satisfied as with marrow and fatness; and my mouth shall praise thee with joyful lips:

Psa 63:6 **When I remember thee upon my bed, and meditate on thee in the night watches.**

Psa 116:2 Because he hath inclined his ear unto me, **therefore will I call upon him as long as I live.**

SET, TO TRUST AS PROTECTOR AND PROVIDER

Psa 91:9 Because **thou hast made the LORD, which is my refuge, even the most High, thy habitation;**

Psa 91:10 There shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling.

Psa 91:11 For he shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways.

Isa 50:7 For the Lord GOD will help me; therefore shall I not be confounded: **therefore have I set my face like a flint,** and I know that I shall not be ashamed.

Isa 50:10 Who is among you that feareth the LORD, that obeyeth the voice of his servant, that walketh in darkness, and hath no light? **let him trust in the name of the LORD, and stay upon his God.**

Psa 16:8 **I have set the LORD always before me:** because he is at my right hand, **I shall not be moved.**

Psa 16:9 Therefore my heart is glad, and my glory rejoiceth: my flesh also shall rest in hope.

Psa 16:11 Thou wilt shew me the path of life: in thy presence is fulness of joy; at thy right hand there are pleasures for evermore.

Psa 62:10 Trust not in oppression, and become not vain in robbery: if riches increase, **set not your heart upon them.**

Psa 62:11 God hath spoken once; twice have I heard this; that power belongeth unto God.

Pro 23:4 Labour not to be rich: cease from thine own wisdom.

Pro 23:5 **Wilt thou set thine eyes upon that which is not?** for riches certainly make themselves wings; they fly away as an eagle toward heaven.

Pro 23:12 **Apply thine heart unto instruction, and thine ears to the words of knowledge.**

Pro 23:23 **Buy** the truth, and sell it not; also wisdom, and instruction, and understanding.

Rom 8:5 For **they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit.**

Rom 8:6 For to be carnally minded is death; but **to be spiritually minded is life and peace.**

1Jn 2:15 **Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world.** If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him.

1Jn 2:16 For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world.

1Jn 2:17 And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but **he that doeth the will of God abideth for ever.**

Psa 112:7 He shall not be afraid of evil tidings: **his heart is fixed, trusting** in the LORD.

Psa 112:8 **His heart is established**, he shall not be afraid, until he see his desire upon his enemies

Psa 25:15 **Mine eyes are ever toward the LORD;** for he shall pluck my feet out of the net.

Psa 121:1 A Song of degrees. **I will lift up mine eyes unto the hills,** from whence cometh my help.

Psa 123:2 Behold, as the eyes of servants look unto the hand of their masters, and as the eyes of a maiden unto the hand of her mistress; **so our eyes wait upon the LORD our God, until that he have mercy upon us.**

Psa 141:8 **But mine eyes are unto thee,** O GOD the Lord: in thee is my trust; leave not my soul destitute.

Mat 6:19 Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal:

Mat 6:20 But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal:

Mat 6:21 For **where your treasure is, there will your heart be also.**

Mat 6:22 The light of the body is the eye: if **therefore thine eye be single, thy whole body shall be full of light.**

Mat 6:23 But if thine eye be evil, thy whole body shall be full of darkness. If therefore the light that is in thee be darkness, how great is that darkness!

Mat 6:24 **No man can serve two masters:** for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.

Mat 6:25 Therefore I say unto you, Take no thought for your life, what ye shall eat, or what ye shall drink; nor yet for your body, what ye shall put on. Is not the life more than meat, and the body than raiment?

Mat 6:26 Behold the fowls of the air: for they sow not, neither do they reap, nor gather into barns; yet **your heavenly Father feedeth them. Are ye not much better than they?**

Mat 6:27 Which of you by taking thought can add one cubit unto his stature?

Mat 6:28 And why take ye thought for raiment? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow; they toil not, neither do they spin:

Mat 6:29 And yet I say unto you, That even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these.

Mat 6:30 Wherefore, if God so clothe the grass of the field, which to day is, and to morrow is cast into the oven, shall he not much more clothe you, O ye of little faith?

Mat 6:31 Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed?

Mat 6:32 (For after all these things do the Gentiles seek:) for your heavenly Father knoweth that ye have need of all these things.

Mat 6:33 **But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.**

Mat 6:34 Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself. Sufficient unto the day is the evil thereof.

Hag 1:5 Now therefore thus saith the LORD of hosts; **Consider your ways.**

Hag 1:6 Ye have sown much, and bring in little; ye eat, but ye have not enough; ye drink, but ye are not filled with drink; ye clothe you, but there is none warm; and he that earneth wages earneth wages to put it into a bag with holes.

Hag 1:7 Thus saith the LORD of hosts; **Consider your ways.**

Psa 27:13 **I had fainted, unless I had believed** to see the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living.

Psa 27:14 **Wait on the LORD: be of good courage, and he shall strengthen thine heart: wait, I say, on the LORD.**

SET TO SEEK AND KNOW HIM

1Ch 22:19 Now **set your heart and your soul to seek the LORD your God**; arise therefore, and build ye the sanctuary of the LORD God, to bring the ark of the covenant of the LORD, and the holy vessels of God, into the house that is to be built to the name of the LORD.

1Ch 16:11 **Seek the LORD and his strength, seek his face continually.**

1Ch 16:12 Remember his marvellous works that he hath done, his wonders, and the judgments of his mouth;

1Ch 28:9 And thou, Solomon my son, know thou the God of thy father, and serve him with a perfect heart and with a willing mind: for the LORD searcheth all hearts, and understandeth all the imaginations of the thoughts: **if thou seek him, he will be found of thee;** but if thou forsake him, he will cast thee off for ever.

Deu 4:29 But **if from thence thou shalt seek the LORD thy God, thou shalt find him, if thou seek him with all thy heart and with all thy soul.**

Psa 27:4 **One thing have I desired of the LORD, that will I seek after;** that I may dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the LORD, and to enquire in his temple.

Luk 10:42 But **one thing is needful:** and Mary hath chosen that good part, which shall not be taken away from her.

Psa 73:26 My flesh and my heart faileth: but God is the strength of my heart, and my portion for ever.

Psa 73:25 **Whom have I in heaven but thee? and there is none upon earth that I desire beside thee.**

Php 3:8 Yea doubtless, and **I count all things but loss for the excellency of the knowledge of Christ Jesus** my Lord: for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and do count them but dung, that I may win Christ,

Php 3:9 And be found in him, not having mine own righteousness, which is of the law, but that which is through the faith of Christ, the righteousness which is of God by faith:

Php 3:10 **That I may know him, and the power of his resurrection,** and the fellowship of his sufferings, being made conformable unto his death;

Pro 8:34 Blessed is the man that heareth me, **watching daily at my gates, waiting at the posts of my doors.**

Pro 8:35 For whoso findeth me findeth life, and shall obtain favour of the LORD.

SET, TO WAIT AND REST

Psa 31:24 Be of good courage, and **he shall strengthen your heart, all ye that hope in the LORD.**

Psa 33:20 **Our soul waiteth for the LORD: he is our help and our shield.**

Psa 62:5 My soul, **wait thou only upon God; for my expectation is from him.**

Psa 130:5 **I wait for the LORD, my soul doth wait, and in his word do I hope.**

Psa 130:6 My soul waiteth for the Lord more than they that watch for the morning: I say, more than they that watch for the morning.

Isa 30:18 And therefore will the LORD wait, that he may be gracious unto you, and therefore will he be exalted, that he may have mercy upon you: for the LORD is a God of judgment: **blessed are all they that wait for him.**

Lam 3:25 **The LORD is good unto them that wait for him, to the soul that seeketh him.**

Lam 3:26 **It is good that a man should both hope and quietly wait for the salvation of the LORD.**

Rom 8:25 But if we hope for that we see not, **then do we with patience wait for it.**

1Co 16:13 **Watch ye, stand fast in the faith, quit you like men, be strong.**

Psa 31:24 Be of good courage, and **he shall strengthen your heart, all ye that hope in the LORD.**

Isa 40:29 He giveth power to the faint; and to them that have no might he increaseth strength.

Isa 40:30 Even the youths shall faint and be weary, and the young men shall utterly fall:

Isa 40:31 **But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.**

Psa 40:1 To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. **I waited patiently for the LORD; and he inclined unto me, and heard my cry.**

Psa 40:2 He brought me up also out of an horrible pit, out of the miry clay, and set my feet upon a rock, and established my goings.

Psa 40:3 And he hath put a new song in my mouth, even praise unto our God: many shall see it, and fear, and shall trust in the LORD.

Psa 37:3 **Trust in the LORD**, and do good; so shalt thou dwell in the land, and verily thou shalt be fed.

Psa 37:4 **Delight thyself also in the LORD**; and he shall give thee the desires of thine heart.

Psa 37:5 **Commit thy way unto the LORD**; trust also in him; and he shall bring it to pass.

Psa 37:6 And he shall bring forth thy righteousness as the light, and thy judgment as the noonday.

Psa 37:7 **Rest in the LORD**, and **wait patiently for him**: fret not thyself because of him who prospereth in his way, because of the man who bringeth wicked devices to pass.

Psa 25:3 Yea, **let none that wait on thee be ashamed**: let them be ashamed which transgress without cause.

Psa 62:1 To the chief Musician, to Jeduthun, A Psalm of David.
Truly my soul waiteth upon God: from him cometh my salvation.
Psa 62:2 He only is my rock and my salvation; he is my defence; **I shall not be greatly moved**.

Isa 30:15 For thus saith the Lord GOD, the Holy One of Israel; **In returning and rest shall ye be saved; in quietness and in confidence shall be your strength**: and ye would not.

Gal 6:9 And **let us not be weary** in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.

Heb 10:35 **Cast not away therefore your confidence**, which hath great recompence of reward.

Heb 10:36 For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise.

SET, YOUR MIND

Rom 8:6 For **to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.**

Rom 8:7 Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be.

Rom 13:14 But **put ye on the Lord Jesus Christ**, and make not provision for the flesh, to fulfil the lusts thereof.

Rom 8:5 For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit.

2Co 10:4 (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;)

2Co 10:5 **Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;**

Eph 4:22 That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts;

Eph 4:23 And **be renewed in the spirit of your mind;**

Eph 4:24 And that ye **put on the new man**, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.

Col 1:21 And you, that were sometime **alienated and enemies in your mind** by wicked works, yet now hath he reconciled

Rom 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but **be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind**, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

Col 3:10 And have **put on the new man**, which is renewed in knowledge after the image of him that created him:

1Pe 1:13 Wherefore **gird up the loins of your mind**, be sober, and hope to the end for the grace that is to be brought unto you at the revelation of Jesus Christ;

Psa 25:14 The secret of the LORD is with them that fear him; and he will shew them his covenant.

Psa 25:15 **Mine eyes are ever toward the LORD**; for he shall pluck my feet out of the net.

Psa 121:1 A Song of degrees. **I will lift up mine eyes** unto the hills, from whence cometh my help.

Psa 121:2 My help cometh from the LORD, which made heaven and earth.

Psa 121:3 He will not suffer thy foot to be moved: he that keepeth thee will not slumber.

Psa 121:4 Behold, he that keepeth Israel shall neither slumber nor sleep.

Psa 121:5 The LORD is thy keeper: the LORD is thy shade upon thy right hand.

Psa 121:6 The sun shall not smite thee by day, nor the moon by night.

Psa 121:7 The LORD shall preserve thee from all evil: he shall preserve thy soul.

Psa 121:8 The LORD shall preserve thy going out and thy coming in from this time forth, and even for evermore.

Psa 57:7 **My heart is fixed, O God, my heart is fixed:** I will sing and give praise.

Psa 108:1 A Song or Psalm of David. O God, **my heart is fixed;** I will sing and give praise, even with my glory.

Psa 132:3 Surely I will not come into the tabernacle of my house, nor go up into my bed;

Psa 132:4 **I will not give sleep to mine eyes, or slumber to mine eyelids,**

Psa 132:5 **Until I find out a place for the LORD, an habitation for the mighty God of Jacob.**
