

Shut Your Mouth!

Pro 29:20 Seest thou a man that is hasty in his words? there is more hope of a fool than of him.

Pro 29:11 A fool uttereth all his mind: but a wise man keepeth it in till afterwards.

Pro 10:19 In the multitude of words there wanteth not sin: but he that refraineth his lips is wise.

Pro 13:3 He that keepeth his mouth keepeth his life: but he that openeth wide his lips shall have destruction.

Ecc 5:1 Keep thy foot when thou goest to the house of God, and be more ready to hear, than to give the sacrifice of fools: for they consider not that they do evil.

Ecc 5:2 Be not rash with thy mouth, and let not thine heart be hasty to utter any thing before

God: for God is in heaven, and thou upon earth:
therefore **let thy words be few.**

Jas 1:19 Wherefore, my beloved brethren, **let every man be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath:**

Pro 14:29 He that is slow to wrath is of great understanding: but **he that is hasty of spirit exalteth folly.**

Pro 12:23 A prudent man concealeth knowledge: but **the heart of fools proclaimeth foolishness.**

James 1:26 If any man among you seem to be religious, and **bridleth not his tongue, but deceiveth his own heart,** this man's religion is vain.

James 3:2 For in many things we offend all. **If any man offend not in word, the same is a perfect man, and able also to bridle the whole body.**

Pro 15:1 **A soft answer turneth away wrath:** but grievous words stir up anger.

Pro 15:2 The tongue of the wise useth knowledge aright: but the mouth of fools poureth out foolishness.

Pro 17:27 **He that hath knowledge spareth his words:** and a man of understanding is of an excellent spirit.

Pro 17:28 **Even a fool, when he holdeth his peace, is counted wise:** and he that shutteth his lips is esteemed a man of understanding.

Pro 18:20 **A man's belly shall be satisfied with the fruit of his mouth;** and with the increase of his lips shall he be filled.

Pro 18:21 **Death and life are in the power of the tongue:** and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof.

Pro 21:23 **Whoso keepeth his mouth and his tongue keepeth his soul from troubles.**

Pro 12:13 **The wicked is snared by the transgression of his lips:** but the just shall come out of trouble.
