

Standing In Awe!

Fear: "standing in awe." This is not simple fear or being afraid, but reverence, whereby an individual **recognizes the power and position of the individual revered and renders him proper respect.**

Mal 3:16 Then **they that feared the LORD spake often one to another:** and the LORD hearkened, and heard it, and **a book of remembrance was written before him for them that feared the LORD, and that thought upon his name.**

Mal 3:17 And they shall be mine, saith the LORD of hosts, in that day when I make up my jewels; and I will spare them, as a man spareth his own son that serveth him.

Mal 4:2 But **unto you that fear my name shall the Sun of righteousness arise with healing in his wings; and ye shall go forth, and grow up as calves of the stall.**

Mal 4:3 And ye shall tread down the wicked; for they shall be ashes under the soles of your feet in the day that I shall do this, saith the LORD of hosts.

Pro 1:7 **The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge:** but fools despise wisdom and instruction.

Psa 34:9 O fear the LORD, ye his saints: for **there is no want to them that fear him.**

Psa 34:10 The young lions do lack, and suffer hunger: but they that seek the LORD shall not want any good thing.

Psa 34:11 Come, ye children, **hearken unto me: I will teach you the fear of the LORD.**

Psa 34:12 What man is he that desireth life, and loveth many days, that he may see good?

Psa 33:18 Behold, **the eye of the LORD is upon them that fear him**, upon them that hope in his mercy;

Pro 8:13 **The fear of the LORD is to hate evil:** pride, and arrogancy, and the evil way, and the froward mouth, do I hate.

Pro 9:10 **The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom:** and the knowledge of the holy is understanding.

Pro 10:27 **The fear of the LORD prolongeth days:** but the years of the wicked shall be shortened.

Pro 14:26 **In the fear of the LORD is strong confidence:** and his children shall have a place of refuge.

Pro 14:27 **The fear of the LORD is a fountain of life,** to depart from the snares of death.

Pro 15:16 **Better is little with the fear of the LORD than great treasure** and trouble therewith.

Pro 15:33 **The fear of the LORD is the instruction of wisdom;** and before honour is humility.

Pro 16:6 By mercy and truth iniquity is purged: and **by the fear of the LORD men depart from evil.**

Pro 19:23 **The fear of the LORD tendeth to life: and he that hath it shall abide satisfied; he shall not be visited with evil.**

Pro 22:4 By humility and **the fear of the LORD are riches, and honour, and life.**

Pro 23:17 Let not thine heart envy sinners: but **be thou in the fear of the LORD all the day long.**

Psa 147:11 **The LORD taketh pleasure in them that fear him, in those that hope in his mercy.**

Psa 111:10 **The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom: a good understanding have all they that do his commandments: his praise endureth for ever.**

Isa 29:13 Wherefore the Lord said, Forasmuch as this people draw near me with their mouth, and with their lips do honour me, but have removed their heart far from me, and **their fear toward me is taught by the precept of men:**

Isa 33:6 And wisdom and knowledge shall be the stability of thy times, and strength of salvation: **the fear of the LORD is his treasure.**

Luk 1:50 And **his mercy is on them that fear him from generation to generation.**

Jer 32:38 And they shall be my people, and I will be their God:

Jer 32:39 And I will give them one heart, and one way, **that they may fear me for ever, for the good of them, and of their children after them:**

Jer 32:40 And I will make an everlasting covenant with them, that I will not turn away from them, to do them good; but I will put my fear in their hearts, that they shall not depart from me.

Act 9:31 Then had the churches rest throughout all Judaea and Galilee and Samaria, and **were edified; and walking in the fear of the Lord, and in the comfort of the Holy Ghost, were multiplied.**

Rom 3:18 There is no fear of God before their eyes.

2Co 7:1 **Having therefore these promises, dearly beloved, let us cleanse ourselves** from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, **perfecting holiness in the fear of God.**

Eph 5:21 **Submitting yourselves one to another in the fear of God.**

Php 2:12 Wherefore, my beloved, as ye have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, **work out your own salvation with fear and trembling.**

1Pe 1:17 And if ye call on the Father, who without respect of persons judgeth according to every man's work, **pass the time of your sojourning here in fear:**

Psa 112:1 Praise ye the LORD. **Blessed is the man that feareth the LORD**, that delighteth greatly in his commandments.

Psa 112:2 His seed shall be mighty upon earth: the generation of the upright shall be blessed.

Psa 112:3 Wealth and riches shall be in his house: and his righteousness endureth for ever.

Ecc 12:13 Let us hear the conclusion of **the whole matter: Fear God, and keep his commandments: for this is the whole duty of man.**

Pro 2:1 My son, if thou wilt **receive my words**, and hide my commandments with thee;

Pro 2:2 So that thou **incline thine ear** unto wisdom, and **apply thine heart** to understanding;

Pro 2:3 Yea, if thou **criest after knowledge**, and **liftest up thy voice for understanding**;

Pro 2:4 If thou **seekest her as silver**, and **searchest for her as for hid treasures**;

Pro 2:5 **Then shalt thou understand the fear of the LORD**, and find the knowledge of God.

Pro 3:5 Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding.

Pro 3:6 In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.

Pro 3:7 **Be not wise in thine own eyes: fear the LORD, and depart from evil.**

Isa 11:1 And there shall come forth a rod out of the stem of Jesse, and a Branch shall grow out of his roots:

Isa 11:2 And the spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, **the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD;**

Isa 11:3 And **shall make him of quick understanding in the fear of the LORD:** and he shall not judge after the sight of his eyes, neither reprove after the hearing of his ears:

Isa 50:10 **Who is among you that feareth the LORD,** that obeyeth the voice of his servant, that walketh in darkness, and hath no light? let him trust in the name of the LORD, and stay upon his God.

Act 10:2 A devout man, and **one that feared God with all his house,** which gave much alms to the people, and prayed to God alway.

Act 10:3 He saw in a vision evidently about the ninth hour of the day an angel of God coming in to him, and saying unto him, Cornelius.

Psa 119:36 Incline my heart unto thy testimonies, and not to covetousness.

Psa 119:37 Turn away mine eyes from beholding vanity; and quicken thou me in thy way.

Psa 119:38 Stablish thy word unto thy servant, **who is devoted to thy fear.**

Pro 1:24 **Because I have called, and ye refused;** I have stretched out my hand, and no man regarded;

Pro 1:25 But ye have set at nought all my counsel, and would none of my reproof:

Pro 1:26 **I also will laugh at your calamity**; I will mock when your fear cometh;

Pro 1:27 When your fear cometh as desolation, and your destruction cometh as a whirlwind; when distress and anguish cometh upon you.

Pro 1:28 Then shall they call upon me, but I will not answer; they shall seek me early, but they shall not find me:

Pro 1:29 **For that they hated knowledge, and did not choose the fear of the LORD:**

Psa 89:7 **God is greatly to be feared in the assembly of the saints, and to be had in reverence of all them that are about him.**

Psa 89:8 O LORD God of hosts, who is a strong LORD like unto thee? or to thy faithfulness round about thee?

Psa 89:9 Thou rulest the raging of the sea: when the waves thereof arise, thou stillest them.

Psa 89:11 The heavens are thine, the earth also is thine: as for the world and the fulness thereof, thou hast founded them.

Psa 89:12 The north and the south thou hast created them: Tabor and Hermon shall rejoice in thy name.

Psa 89:13 Thou hast a mighty arm: strong is thy hand, and high is thy right hand.

Rev 15:3 And they sing the song of Moses the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying, Great and marvellous are thy works, Lord God Almighty; just and true are thy ways, thou King of saints.

Rev 15:4 **Who shall not fear thee, O Lord, and glorify thy name?** for thou only art holy: for **all nations shall come and worship before thee**; for thy judgments are made manifest.

Psa 115:13 **He will bless them that fear the LORD, both small and great.**

Psa 115:14 The LORD shall increase you more and more, you and your children.

Psa 115:15 Ye are blessed of the LORD which made heaven and earth.

Isa 66:2 For all those things hath mine hand made, and all those things have been, saith the LORD: **but to this man will I look, even to him that is poor and of a contrite spirit, and trembleth at my word.**

Gen 22:10 And Abraham stretched forth his hand, and took the knife to slay his son.

Gen 22:11 And the angel of the LORD called unto him out of heaven, and said, Abraham, Abraham: and he said, Here am I.

Gen 22:12 And he said, Lay not thine hand upon the lad, neither do thou any thing unto him: **for now I know that thou fearest God,** seeing thou hast not withheld thy son, thine only son from me.

Abraham respected and honored God by being willing to sacrifice his only son, God would one day sacrifice His only Son!

Heb 12:29 For our God is a consuming fire.
