Pro 6:9 **How long wilt thou sleep, O sluggard?**
when wilt thou arise out of thy sleep?

Isa 60:1 **Arise, shine;** for thy light is come, and the
glory of the LORD is risen upon thee.

Isa 60:2 For, behold, the darkness shall cover the
earth, and gross darkness the people: but the LORD
shall arise upon thee, and his glory shall be seen
upon thee.

Eph 5:14 Wherefore he saith, **Awake thou that
sleepest, and arise from the dead,** and Christ shall
give thee light.

Isa 9:2 **The people that walked in darkness have
seen a great light: they that dwell in the land of
the shadow of death,** upon them hath the light
shined.

Mat 4:16 The people which sat in darkness saw great light; and to them which sat in the region and shadow of death light is sprung up.

Isa 52:1 **Awake, awake; put on thy strength,** O Zion; put on thy beautiful garments, O Jerusalem, the holy city: for henceforth there shall no more come into thee the uncircumcised and the unclean.

Isa 52:2 **Shake thyself from the dust; arise,** and sit down, O Jerusalem: loose thyself from the bands of thy neck, O captive daughter of Zion.

Isa 52:3 For thus saith the LORD, Ye have sold yourselves for nought; and ye shall be redeemed without money.

Isa 21:5 Prepare the table, watch in the watchtower, eat, drink: **arise, ye princes,** and anoint the shield.

Joh 8:12 Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, **I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.**

Joh 12:35 Then Jesus said unto them, Yet a little while is the light with you. **Walk while ye have the light, lest darkness come upon you:** for he that walketh in darkness knoweth not whither he goeth.

Joh 11:9 Jesus answered, Are there not twelve hours in the day? **If any man walk in the day, he stumbleth not,** because he seeth the light of this world.

Joh 11:10 But if a man walk in the night, he stumbleth, because there is no light in him.

Pro 4:18 But **the path of the just is as the shining light, that shineth more and more unto the perfect day.**

Pro 4:19 The way of the wicked is as darkness: they know not at what they stumble.

1Jn 2:10 **He that loveth his brother abideth in the light, and there is none occasion of stumbling in him.**

Joh 12:46 I am come a light into the world, that **whosoever believeth on me should not abide in darkness.**

Eph 5:8 For ye were sometimes darkness, but now are ye light in the Lord: **walk as children of light:**

Joh 9:5 As long as I am in the world, **I am the light of the world.**

2Co 4:6 For God, who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

2Co 4:7 But **we have this treasure in earthen vessels**, that the excellency of the power may be of God, and not of us.

Rom 13:11 And that, knowing the time, that now **it is high time to awake out of sleep**: for now is our salvation nearer than when we believed.

Rom 13:12 The night is far spent, the day is at hand: **let us therefore cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armour of light.**

Rom 13:13 Let us walk honestly, as in the day; not in rioting and drunkenness, not in chambering and wantonness, not in strife and envying.

Rom 13:14 But **put ye on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make not provision for the flesh**, to fulfil the lusts thereof.
