

Word= Power!

Luk 4:32 And they were astonished at his doctrine: for **his word was with power.**

Joh 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and **the Word was God.**

1Co 2:1 And I, brethren, when I came to you, came **not with excellency of speech or of wisdom**, declaring unto you the testimony of God.

1Co 2:4 And my speech and my preaching was **not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power:**

1Co 2:5 That your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.

1Co 1:17 For Christ sent me not to baptize, but **to preach the gospel: not with wisdom of words**, lest the cross of Christ should be made of none effect.

1Co 1:18 For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved **it is the power of God.**

1Th 1:5 For **our gospel came not unto you in word only, but also in power**, and in the Holy Ghost, and in much assurance; as ye know what manner of men we were among you for your sake.

Joh 6:63 It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: **the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life.**

Act 14:3 Long time therefore abode they **speaking boldly in the Lord**, which gave **testimony unto the word of his grace**, and **granted signs and wonders to be done by their hands**.

Rom 15:19 **Through mighty signs and wonders, by the power of the Spirit of God**; so that from Jerusalem, and round about unto Illyricum, **I have fully preached the gospel of Christ**.

Rom 1:16 For I am not ashamed of **the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God** unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.

1Co 1:24 But unto them which are called, both Jews and Greeks, **Christ the power of God, and the wisdom of God**.

1Th 2:13 For this cause also thank we God without ceasing, because, when ye received the word of God which ye heard of us, ye received it not as the word of men, but as it is in truth, **the word of God, which effectually worketh also in you that believe**.

2Co 6:7 **By the word of truth, by the power of God**, by the armour of righteousness on the right hand and on the left,

Luk 4:36 And they were all amazed, and spake among themselves, saying, **What a word is this! for with authority and power he commandeth the unclean spirits, and they come out**.

Luk 10:19 Behold, **I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy**: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Jer 23:28 The prophet that hath a dream, let him tell a dream; and he that hath my word, let him speak my word faithfully. What is the chaff to the wheat? saith the LORD.

Jer 23:29 **Is not my word like as a fire? saith the LORD; and like a hammer that breaketh the rock in pieces?**

Jer 5:14 Wherefore thus saith the LORD God of hosts, **Because ye speak this word, behold, I will make my words in thy mouth fire, and this people wood, and it shall devour them.**

Jer 20:9 Then I said, I will not make mention of him, nor speak any more in his name. **But his word was in mine heart as a burning fire shut up in my bones,** and I was weary with forbearing, and I could not stay.

Luk 24:32 And they said one to another, **Did not our heart burn within us, while he talked with us by the way, and while he opened to us the scriptures?**

Joh 6:63 It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: **the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life.**

1Pe 1:23 Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, **by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever.**

Joh 6:68 Then Simon Peter answered him, Lord, to whom shall we go? thou hast **the words of eternal life.**

Psa 119:50 This is my comfort in my affliction: for **thy word hath quickened me.**

Rom 10:6 But the righteousness which is of faith speaketh on this wise, Say not in thine heart, Who shall ascend into heaven? (that is, to bring Christ down from above:)

Rom 10:7 Or, Who shall descend into the deep? (that is, to bring up Christ again from the dead.)

Rom 10:8 But what saith it? **The word is nigh thee, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, the word of faith, which we preach;**

Heb 4:12 For **the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.**

Mat 7:28 And it came to pass, when **Jesus had ended these sayings, the people were astonished at his doctrine:**

Mat 7:29 For **he taught them as one having authority, and not as the scribes.**

2Co 4:6 For God, who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, **to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.**

2Co 4:7 But **we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellency of the power may be of God, and not of us.**

Act 4:29 And now, Lord, behold their threatenings: and grant unto thy servants, that **with all boldness they may speak thy word,**

Act 4:30 By stretching forth thine hand to heal; and that signs and wonders may be done by the name of thy holy child Jesus.

Act 4:31 And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the word of God with boldness.

Mar 16:20 And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with them, and confirming the word with signs following. Amen.

Act 8:4 Therefore they that were scattered abroad went every where preaching the word.

Act 8:5 Then Philip went down to the city of Samaria, and preached Christ unto them.

Act 8:6 And the people with one accord gave heed unto those things which Philip spake, hearing and seeing the miracles which he did.

Act 8:7 For unclean spirits, crying with loud voice, came out of many that were possessed with them: and many taken with palsies, and that were lame, were healed.

Act 8:8 And there was great joy in that city.

Heb 2:2 For if the word spoken by angels was stedfast, and every transgression and disobedience received a just recompence of reward;

Heb 2:3 How shall we escape, if we neglect so great salvation; which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed unto us by them that heard him;

Heb 2:4 God also bearing them witness, both with signs and wonders, and with divers miracles, and gifts of the Holy Ghost, according to his own will?

2Co 4:2 But have renounced the hidden things of dishonesty, not walking in craftiness, **nor handling the word of God deceitfully; but by manifestation of the truth** commending ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God.

Psa 119:130 **The entrance of thy words giveth light;** it giveth understanding unto the simple.

Isa 55:10 For as the rain cometh down, and the snow from heaven, and returneth not thither, but watereth the earth, and maketh it bring forth and bud, that it may give seed to the sower, and bread to the eater:

Isa 55:11 **So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it.**

1Pe 2:2 As newborn babes, **desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby:**

Isa 11:4 But with righteousness shall he judge the poor, and reprove with equity for the meek of the earth: and **he shall smite the earth with the rod of his mouth, and with the breath of his lips shall he slay the wicked.**

Act 2:37 **Now when they heard this, they were pricked in their heart,** and said unto Peter and to the rest of the apostles, Men and brethren, **what shall we do?**

Act 5:33 **When they heard that, they were cut to the heart, and took counsel to slay them.**

Eph 6:17 And take the helmet of salvation, and **the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God:**

Rev 1:16 And he had in his right hand seven stars: and **out of his mouth went a sharp twoedged sword:** and his countenance was as the sun shineth in his strength.

Rev 2:16 Repent; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will fight against them **with the sword of my mouth.**

Rev 19:15 **And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword,** that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.
